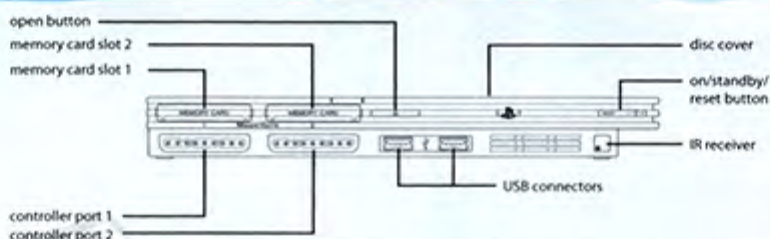

GETTING STARTED



Set up your PlayStation[®]2 computer entertainment system according to the directions in its Instruction Manual. Make sure the MAIN POWER switch (located on the back of the console) is turned on. Press the RESET button. When the power indicator lights up, press the OPEN button and the disc tray will open. Place the Barnyard disc on the disc tray with the label side facing up. Press the OPEN button again and the disc tray will close. Attach game controllers and other peripherals, as appropriate. Follow on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

MEMORY CARD (8MB)(FOR PLAYSTATION[®]2)

To save game settings and progress, insert a memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation[®]2) into MEMORY CARD slot 1 of your PlayStation[®]2 system. You can load saved game data from the same memory card or any memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation[®]2) containing previously saved games.

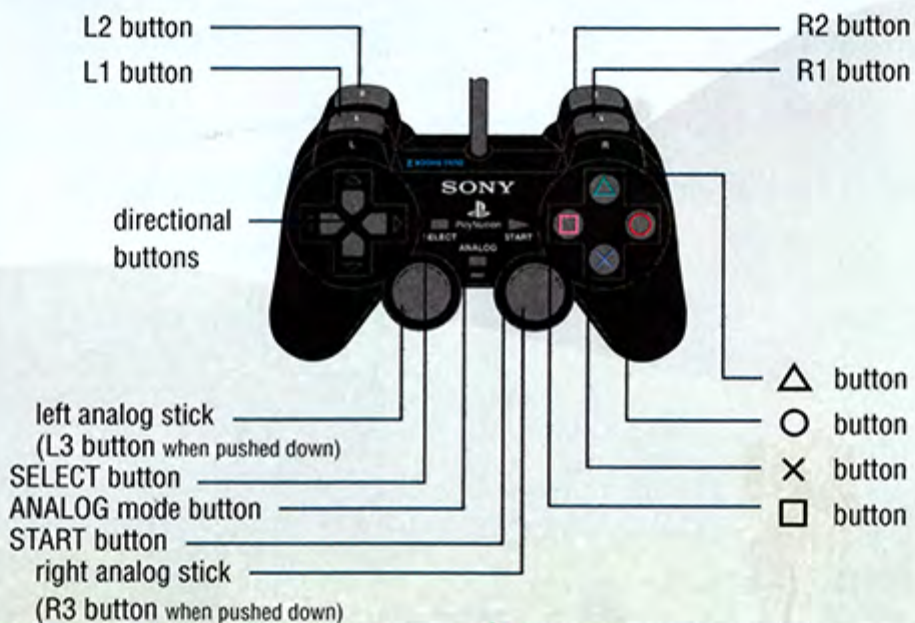
GAME PROFILES

In order to save and/or track your progress through the game, you will need to create or load a Game Profile. If a memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation[®]2) is present the first time you load the game, you will automatically be taken to the Create Profile screen. If you insert the memory card afterward, you can access the Create Profile screen by selecting "New Game" and then selecting an empty game slot.

After selecting a save game slot, the intro movie will begin and you will be asked to choose a cow. Make selections by pressing the **X** button. Use the **△** button to go back. After entering your name with the directional buttons, select "OK" and press the **X** button.

MISSIONS
