INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Only with perfect timing, rhythm and flair will you be able to earn your way onstage and become part of one of pop's biggest concert events. As an added bonus, the points you accumulate during your auditions help you open up lots of cool, exclusive behind the scenes videos of Britney and her crew. The chance of a lifetime has grooved its way right into your lap. Show the world you have what it takes to make it big.

GETTING STARTED



Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. Make sure the MAIN POWER switch (located in the back of the console) is turned on. Press the RESET button. When the power indicator lights up, press the open button and the disc tray will open. Place the Britney's Dance Beat™ disc on the disc tray with the label side facing up. Press the open button again and the disc tray will close. Attach game controllers and other peripherals, as appropriate. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

MEMORY CARDS

To save game settings and progress, insert Memory Card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) into MEMORY CARD slot 1. You can load saved game data from the same card, or any Memory Card containing previously saved Britney's Dance Beat™ games.

AUDITION

Get a first-hand look at any character dancing to any song. See *Preview* on page 9 for more information.

VIDEO VAULT

Once you've earned various backstage passes, you can view videos located within the vault. See *Video Vault* on page 10 for more information.

OPTIONS

Use the directional buttons to select the item you want to change, then press the X button. On each Option screen, use the directional buttons to move between items to make your selection and press the triangle button to confirm and exit the screen.

CAPTION

Turn in-game captions on or off. Use the directional buttons to make your selection. Press the X button to confirm your choice and return to the previous screen. Press the triangle button to cancel and return to the previous screen.

SOUND

To customize your dance experience, you can choose between Stereo or Mono sound output, and change the volume of the background music and sound effects. Press the X button to confirm your selections and return to the previous screen. Press the triangle button to cancel and return to the previous screen.

VIBRATION

You can turn the vibration function on or off from here. Use the directional buttons to make your selection, and then press the X button to return to the previous screen. Press the triangle button to cancel and return to the previous screen.

SAVE/LOAD

Save or load data using a memory card. You can also select the Auto Save feature from this screen. By turning this feature on, the game will automatically save your progress as necessary. Use the directional buttons to highlight your selection, and then press the X button to confirm your selection. Once you've made your choice, press the triangle button to return to the previous screen.

CONTROLS

You can switch the main button controls between Mode 1 (dance pad), Mode 2 (icons) and Mode 3 (directional buttons). Use the directional buttons to highlight your selection, and then press the X button to confirm your choice and return to the previous screen. Press the triangle button to cancel and return to the previous screen.

AUDITION

This is the main 1-Player Mode where you will try to make a name for yourself and earn a spot as one of Britney's dancers. After selecting this mode, use the directional buttons to choose your character, and then press the START button or X button. If you have already played with this character, you'll have the option to start a new game or continue a previously saved game. Make your choice and press the X button to confirm. You will advance to the Music Selection screen. Make your song selection, and then press the X button to begin your audition.



While auditioning, you will dance on-screen with a competitor to a partial version of each of the five songs. On the left side of the screen is a Button Meter. Inside the Button Meter you will see a rotating green bar, or Button Gauge, moving in a clockwise direction. As the green bar passes directly over a button, that button should be pressed.



The circle inside the Button Meter shows how many button combos you've performed in a row. The bigger your combo score, the better shot you have at winning the round. Once a player reaches 10 button combos in a row, your meter will automatically throw "bad moves" at your competitor's meter. These "moves" will alter the level of difficulty by adding an extra button command, changing a button command, or moving a button command to another

part of the meter. The better you perform, the more chances you have to throw bad moves at your competitor.

NOTE: Certain bad moves are associated with specific characters. Pay close attention and you'll know what to look for.

Below the Button Meter at the bottom of the screen is a Player Status Meter showing who is winning the competition. A red slider moves from side to side based on player performance. At the end of the competition, the winner is determined by how close the slider is to that person. You are also awarded points based on your performance and the number of combinations completed. Accumulating points helps you gain backstage passes that unlock video clips stored in the Video Vault (see page 10). Once you've bested the first round of competition, you will have to go through a second round of auditions, this time to a full version of each song.

Once you've successfully completed all of the auditions, you'll have a chance to audition against Britney herself in the final competition.

PRACTICE

Not ready to compete yet? Try practicing the moves first. At the Title Screen, choose

Practice and press the START button or X button. In Practice mode, you can train yourself to become the next dancing sensation for when it matters most — during the actual audition. Using the directional buttons, select the character you want to practice with, and then press the START button or X button. Now make your music selection, and whether you want to dance to a Normal (partial) version of the song or the Full version of the song. Next, make your Level Adjustment to increase or decrease the difficulty of the dance.

Once the music ends, the practice session is over and the results are displayed. Then Britney will come out to evaluate your performance. To practice with the same character and same music, press Restart. To practice with different music, press Music Select. To quit Practice,

select Quit. You can make these same selections during practice by pressing the START button.

2-PLAYER MODE

At the Title Screen, select 2-Player from the menu and press the START button or X button.

Both players must select a character by using the directional buttons to move the cursor and the X button to select.



At the next screen, choose the Music. If one of the players is less experienced than the other, you can even the playing field by making a Level Adjustment. Simply raise the more experienced player's bar up a notch or two. When all the selections are made, each player must then press the X button to get the competition started.



PREVIEW

If you want to see how the pros dance, or practice the moves yourself, select the Preview mode from the Title screen. Use the directional buttons to move the cursor over to the character you want to see dance, then press the X button to make your choice. At the next screen, select the music you want the dancer to groove to and press the X button. Now sit back and watch the show!

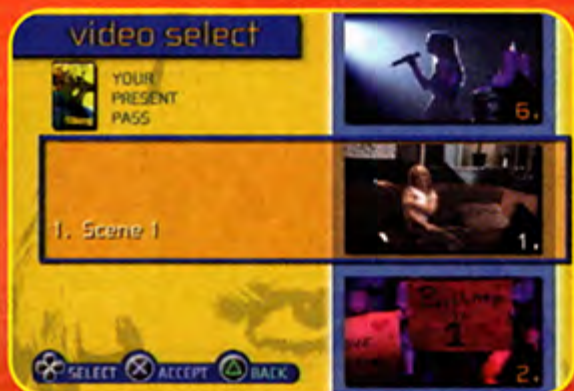

VIDEO VAULT

As you accumulate points during your auditions you will obtain backstage passes. Depending on the level of the pass, you'll be able to view exclusive videos of Britney and the gang behind the scenes and on tour. You'll need to collect six passes in all:

- Local
- Executive Seating
- VIP
- Family and Friends
- Touring Staff
- Universal



Use the directional buttons to select the Video Vault at the Main Title screen, then press the START button or the X button to continue. Use the directional buttons to highlight either Behind the Scenes or Immersive Video, then press the START button or the X button. If you try to select a video without earning a pass, you'll meet Q, Britney's Security Guard, who will tell you to go back to the game to earn a pass. Based on the pass you've collected, you'll have a select number of videos to watch. To unlock the others, you must earn enough points to obtain all the passes.



BEHIND THE SCENES

Get a first-hand look at what goes on when the cameras aren't rolling. See exclusive behind the scenes footage of Britney's concert tour, photo shoots, and video sessions.

IMMERSIVE VIDEO

Get an up-close insider's view of Britney live. See five of her hottest songs performed during tour rehearsals and in concert. You can even move the camera 360 degrees to view the show and the surrounding audience from multiple angles.

SONGS

Britney's Dance Beat™ features two of Britney's newest songs, "I'm a Slave 4 U" and "Overprotected," along with three Britney classics, "...Baby One More Time," "Stronger," and "Oops!...I Did It Again." As you successfully perform each song, a new song will become unlocked.



SONGS

"...BABY ONE MORE TIME" *From the album ...Baby One More Time*
Released in October 1998, this song (along with the video) catapulted Britney onto the national scene. A long way from her Mouseketeer roots, Britney's school-girl-gone-bad ditty was a fixture in the Top 40 for 24 weeks and spent three on top at #1. The album of the same name followed in January 1999 and debuted #1 on the Billboard 200 where it spent six weeks, eventually going platinum more than 13 times over.

"OOPS!...I DID IT AGAIN" *From the album Oops!...I Did It Again*
"Oops!...I Did It Again," Britney's first single off her sophomore album, was released in April 2000. A record number 155 radio stations added this song to their playlists that week. The song spent five weeks at #1 and 17 weeks in the Top 40. The video was nominated for four 2000 MTV Music Video Awards (Best Female Video, Best Pop Video, Best Dance Video, and Viewer's Choice).

"STRONGER" *From the album Oops!...I Did It Again*
"Stronger" was the third single off *Oops!...I Did It Again*, released in November 2000. The single peaked at #8 on the charts where it spent a total of 12 weeks in the Top 40. The video was nominated for a 2001 MTV Video Music Award for Best Pop Video.

"I'M A SLAVE 4 U" *From the album Britney*
Britney (and an albino snake!) debuted this song on the 2001 MTV Video Music Awards. The first single released off her third album, *Britney*, hit the Top 40 in October 2001. The full-length album followed in November. *Britney* became her third album to debut at #1 on the Billboard Top 200. The album sold 700,000 copies the first week of its release in the U.S.

"OVERPROTECTED" *From the album Britney*
The second track off Britney's latest album, "Overprotected," is featured in Britney's first major motion picture, "Crossroads."

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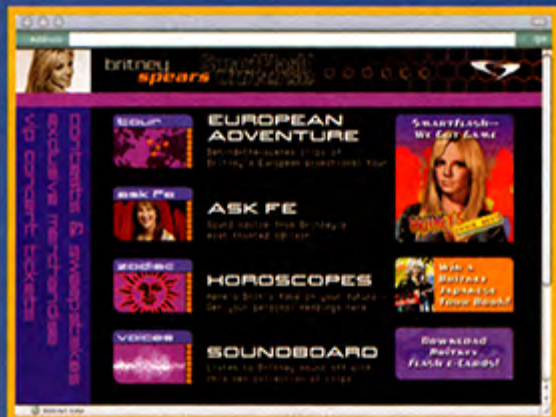
