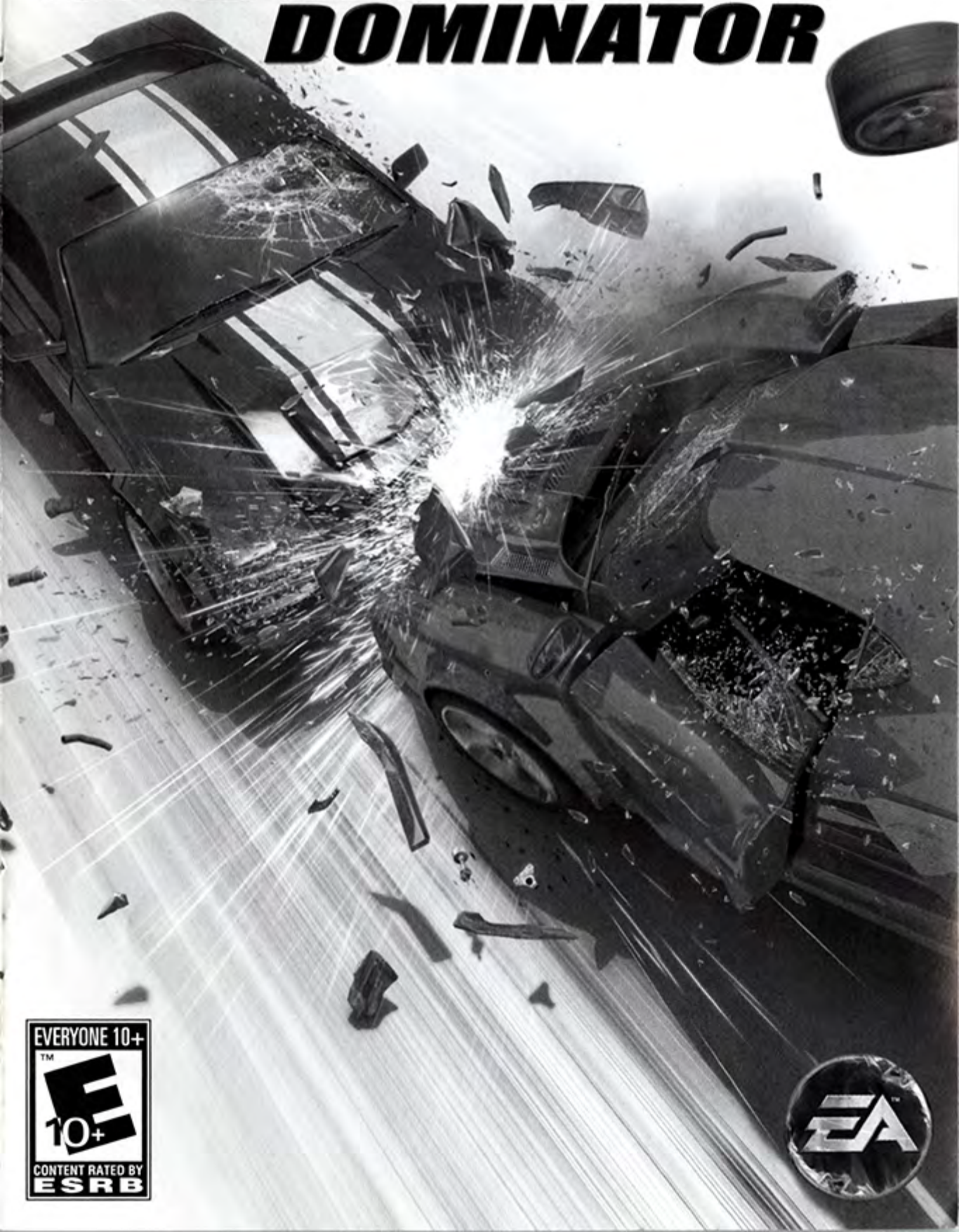

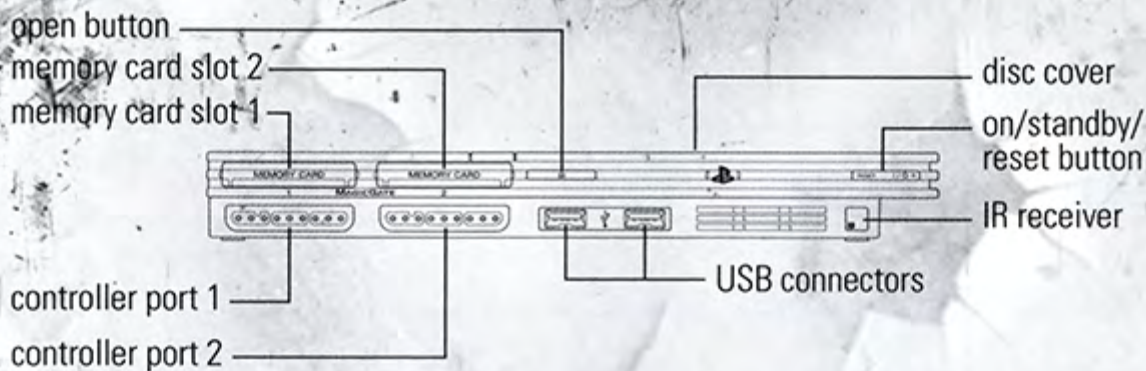

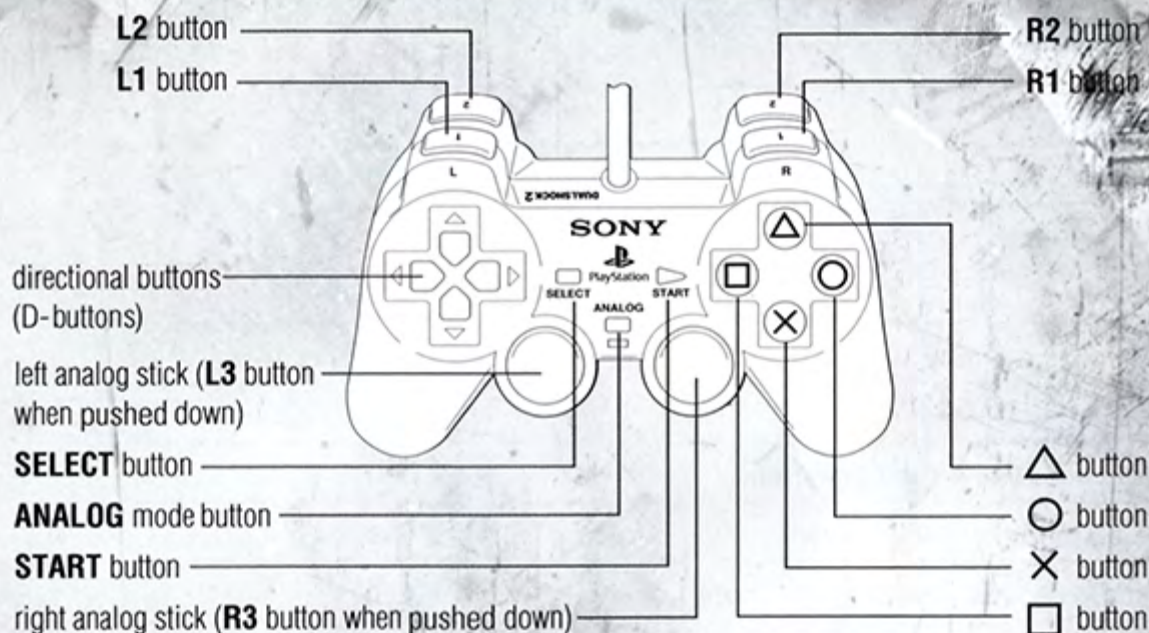
GETTING STARTED



1. Set up your PlayStation[®]2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system.
2. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green).
3. Press the OPEN button to open the disc cover.
4. Place the *Burnout™ Dominator* disc with the label side facing up in the disc holder, and then close the disc cover.
5. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate.
6. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

INTRODUCTION

Dominate roads built for speed and sweep aside your dueling rivals with a searing display of reflexes, nerves, and dangerous racing. Steel yourself for a high-octane head rush through a new World Tour. Master the handling of each vehicle class and blaze your trail across a panorama of open and urban landscapes. Wage a bitter battle for domination as you blitz through locations that challenge you to push yourself to the very edges of control. Flaunt your skills and take outrageous risks to grab the greatest rewards. It's time to dominate.

SETTING UP THE GAME

Most of the game modes and menu options in *Burnout Dominator* are self-explanatory and are therefore not covered in this manual. Exceptions are listed below.

YOUR PROFILE

To save your game progression, you must create a Profile. Your Profile also stores your game settings and preferences.

- To manage Profiles, select DRIVER DETAILS from the Main menu, then select PROFILE.

WORLD TOUR

Experience the burning insanity of hurtling through urban cityscapes and tearing past wide-open country as you tangle with the traffic. Slam and shove your rivals off the asphalt in an array of exotic locations from around the world. Each one has its own challenges to master across seven unlockable vehicle Series.

- Read the scrolling text above a locked event to find out how to unlock it. Events that you've unlocked but have yet to take on are marked **NEW**. When you compete in the event, this text is either replaced by the kind of medal you won or disappears if you failed to do so. Not all events in each Series are available at once—medal success in one unlocks another.

NOTE: Before switching on the ignition and beginning your quest for domination, ensure you're fully up to speed by checking out the tutorial. To do so, select **DRIVER DETAILS** in the Main menu, then choose **EXTRAS**, then select **BASIC TRAINING MOVIE**.

DOMINATOR POINTS

It's all about earning these beauties. After each single player event, your performance is weighed up. Unlock Signature Shortcuts, inflict Takedowns, earn Near Misses, achieve Burnouts, complete Rival Challenges, unlock Trophy rewards, win Gold medals, and unlock individual cars to earn Dominator Points. Earn enough Points to unlock the next Series of vehicles.

FUEL THE BOOST

Execute Takedowns, accomplish huge drifts, perform precision near misses, and get explosive payback with your Crashbreakers to fuel your boost bar. Max out your bar to achieve Supercharge Boost, then keep burning that blue flame in one hit to achieve a Burnout.

BURNOUT CHAINING

Keep up the extreme driving—*while Supercharge Boosting*—to refuel your boost bar and earn while you burn. Link your Burnouts together in Burnout chains. These result in score multipliers or, when racing against rivals, faster lap times.

DOMINATOR TIP: You can't earn while you burn unless you're using Supercharge Boost.

TAKEDOWNS

Slamming a rival off the road is the ultimate form of domination. It not only gets you ahead, it injects a shot of instant boost.

- Inflicting a Takedown refuels your boost bar, but crashing depletes it. If you're boost chaining as you take a rival down, your Takedown delivers enough boost for a full refuel.
- Revenge Takedowns—If a rival slams you off the track with a Takedown, they're marked in red for revenge.

IMPACT TIME AND AFTERTOUCH

Once you've crashed, enter Impact Time. This slows down time and helps you guide your wreck (Aftertouch) into the path of your rivals to hit them with an Aftertouch Takedown.

CRASHBREAKERS

In some single player events, you're able to detonate your vehicle and ignite your boost with a devastating Crashbreaker—the bigger your boost bar, the bigger the bang. Score bitter payback on whoever took you down or catch another rival within range of your fireball.

To use Aftertouch and Crashbreakers:

1. Immediately after you crash, hold the **R1** button to enter Impact Time.
2. Use the left analog stick to guide your wreck into an optimal position to wreak an Aftertouch Takedown on any following rivals.
3. Press the **R2** button to detonate your ride with a Crashbreaker and maximize your chances of catching rivals in the Crashbreaker Takedown fireball.
4. After the explosion, use Aftertouch again in a last-ditch effort to catch another rival in your wreck.

NEW SIGNATURE SHORTCUTS

Shave seconds off your lap time and earn Dominator Points by unlocking a Signature Shortcut at each location. To open up a shortcut, slam a rival into it for a Signature Shortcut takedown.

- To view snapshots of the shortcuts available at each location, select DRIVER DETAILS in the Main menu, then REWARDS, then SIGNATURE SHORTCUTS.

DOMINATOR TIP: Once you've opened a shortcut, it stays that way—so unlock them all to set the fastest Burning Lap times possible.

EVENT TYPES

NEW MANIAC

Draw on all of your driving ability to maximize your Maniac Score. Keep driving like a maniac and chaining your Burnouts to earn massive score multipliers.

NEW BURNOUT/DRIFT/ NEAR MISS CHALLENGE

Display your mastery of the specified skill challenge to rack up your score. Chain your Burnouts to ramp it up to the max.

DOMINATOR TIP: Missing oncoming traffic gains you a bigger score than missing same-way traffic.

RACE

Dodge and weave through oncoming traffic as you take down your rivals in a bid to seize pole position by the time you finish the last lap.

BURNING LAP ROAD RAGE

Do whatever it takes to get across the finish line.

Achieve your Takedown targets to grab a medal placing within the allotted time. Achieve enough Takedowns to extend your time—but watch out for critical damage to your ride that could end the fun early.

ELIMINATOR

Get ahead of the pack, because the car bringing up the rear when the timer runs down is toast.

GRAND PRIX

A multi-race scramble for the finish line. End a race and rack up the points. Earn enough for a final medal placing at the end of the Grand Prix.

NEW RIVAL CHALLENGE

Complete a goal in certain locations—such as inflicting a Takedown on a target car—to add a new car from the current Series to your Garage and unlock a Rival Challenge. There are four Rival Challenges to take on in each Series. Complete all of them to access the Series' Dominator Challenge.

NEW DOMINATOR CHALLENGE

Complete all four Rival Challenges in a Series to unlock the Dominator Challenge. Grab a Gold medal in the Dominator Challenge and you'll finally get the keys to the Series' Dominator car.

DOMINATOR TIP: The winner of a Grand Prix or Series Race event gets six points; second place gets four. Don't settle for second place!

YOUR GARAGE AND CAR UNLOCKS

Each vehicle that you unlock is kept in your Garage. To unlock the cars in a Series, complete its Rival Challenges (see *Rival Challenge* above).

- Select DRIVER DETAILS in the Main menu, then REWARDS, then GARAGE to view the cars you've unlocked.
- Once you unlock a vehicle Series, you also unlock its movie. Access it by selecting EXTRAS in the Driver Details menu.

DOMINATOR TIP: If you're having trouble getting Gold in an event, return to it when you've unlocked a new vehicle in the Series.

TROPHIES

Set your sights on winning five trophies as a reward for your skill—from Rookie to Elite. Fulfill a group of seven tasks to claim a trophy. Each group's tasks get harder to achieve, but each task you complete adds to your Dominator Point total.

- Select DRIVER DETAILS in the Main menu, then REWARDS, then TROPHIES and check on the status of your tasks.

DOMINATOR TIP: Even though you may not finish in the medals during an event, you can still accomplish a trophy task.

OTHER GAME MODES

RECORD BREAKER

Choose an unlocked location and ride, then pull out all the stops in your attempt to smash the event record and earn big Dominator Points.

MULTIPLAYER

In Multiplayer mode, all shortcuts, locations, and vehicles are unlocked.

- Select EDIT PLAYER NAMES in Party Play to personalize player identities and keep track of whose turn is next.

Split Screen

Tear the screen in half and play Split Screen against a friend in Race, Road Rage, Eliminator, and Maniac modes.

NOTE: A multiplayer Road Rage event lasts two laps. The red team aims to take out the blue team, while the blue team tries to evade them until time runs out.

Party Play

Rip up the asphalt with up to three other players. Take part in a Single Event or stretch your skills across multiple modes and events in a Series.

DOMINATOR TIP: There are no points awarded for Takedowns in multiplayer Maniac mode, but if you can take out a rival, they'll lose their score multiplier.

SAVING AND LOADING

Your progress is automatically saved to the memory card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) in MEMORY CARD slot 1 via the Autosave feature.

Saving

- To save your progress manually, select DRIVER DETAILS from the Main menu, choose PROFILE, then select SAVE.
- To toggle the Autosave feature on or off, select AUTOSAVE from the Profile menu.

Loading

Load your preferred Profile (or create a new one) before the game starts to load a game.

- To load your Profile manually after you've started the game, select DRIVER DETAILS from the Main menu, choose PROFILE, then select LOAD.
