Take a 15-minute break during each hour of play.

Stop using the system immediately if you experience any of the following symptoms: lightheadedness, nausea, or a sensation similar to motion sickness; discomfort or pain in the eyes, ears, hands, arms, or any other part of the body. If the condition persists, consult a doctor.

Do not connect your PlayStation 2 system to a projection TV without first consulting the user manual for your projection TV, unless it is of the LCD type. Otherwise, it may permanently damage your TV screen.

HANDLING YOUR PLAYSTATION 2 FORMAT DISC:

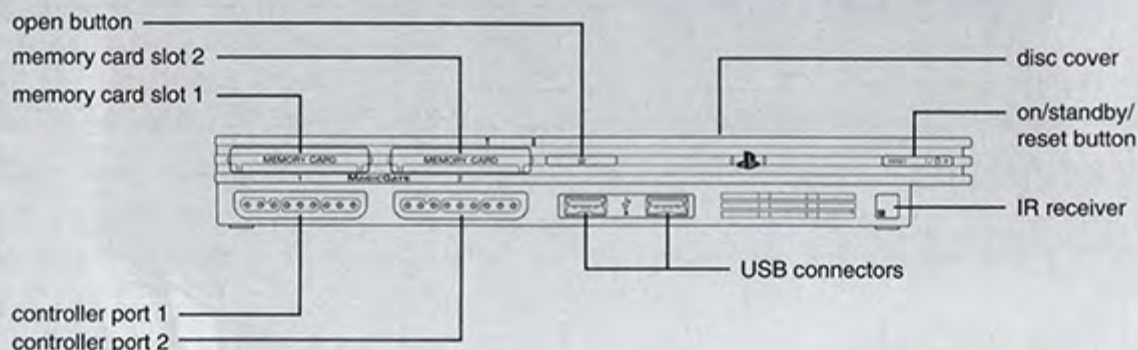
- This disc is intended for use only with PlayStation 2 consoles with the NTSC U/C designation.
- Do not bend it, crush it or submerge it in liquids.
- Do not leave it in direct sunlight or near a radiator or other source of heat.
- Be sure to take an occasional rest break during extended play.
- Keep this compact disc clean. Always hold the disc by the edges and keep it in its protective case when not in use. Clean the disc with a lint-free, soft, dry cloth, wiping in straight lines from center to outer edge. Never use solvents or abrasive cleaners.

GETTING STARTED



Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green). Insert the Crazy Frog Arcade Racer disc in the system with the label side facing up. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

Memory Card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2)

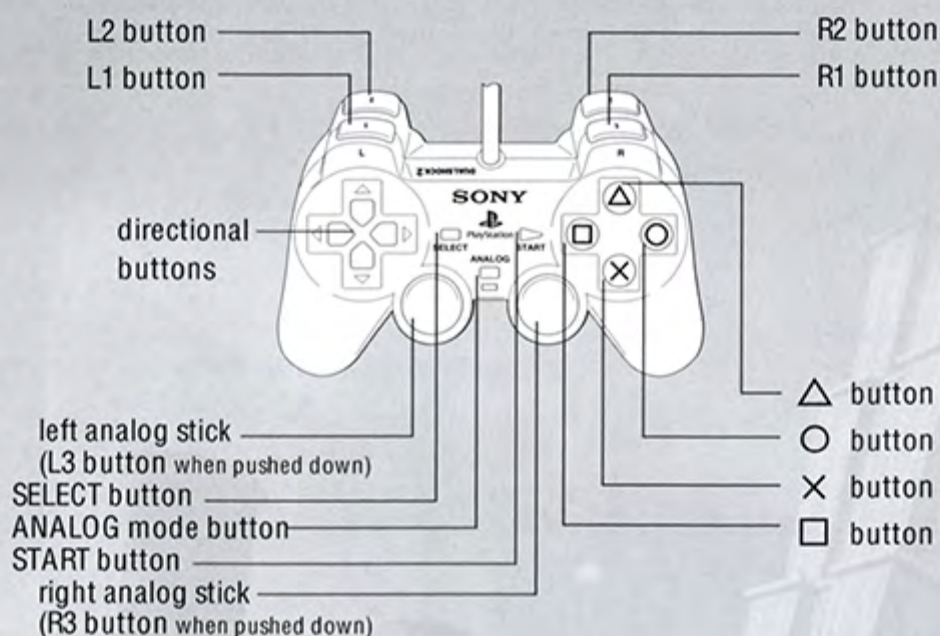
To save game settings and progress, insert a memory card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) into MEMORY CARD slot 1 of your PlayStation®2 system. You can load saved game data from the same memory card or any memory card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) containing previously saved games.

This title will autoload a previously saved game when it first starts, allowing you to continue your progress automatically.

Note: When a profile is loaded, auto-save is automatically enabled for that profile, even if you had turned it off before saving the profile, allowing you to save your progress automatically.

CONTROLS

Note: If you intend to play two player mode, please ensure that two controllers are attached prior to turning on your console.

MAIN MENU

Navigate the menu using the directional buttons. Select an option by pressing the X button. Go back to the previous screen by pressing the Δ button.

ONE PLAYER

Select this mode to confront competitors in a championship, single race, pursuit race or time trials. You also have access to two crazy mini-games: Crazy Dance and Crazy Pinball.

TWO PLAYER

Select this mode to go head to head with up to two players in championship, single race, or battle mode. You'll need to have two controllers connected before selecting this option.

RECORDS

View the high scores of your best performances in single-player.

OPTIONS

Adjust the various game settings such as Sound, Display, Controller configuration and Vibration.

VIDEO BOX

Select this option to see the bonus videos included on the game disc.

LOAD DATA

Load data previously saved on a MEMORY CARD(8MB)(for PlayStation®2) inserted in memory card slot 1.

SAVING

Crazy Frog Arcade Racer uses an Autosave feature, so please ensure you have the memory card you wish to use for loading and saving inserted before beginning the game.

Saving occurs automatically, but only in single player mode during Championship, Single Race, Pursuit and Time Trial modes. In addition, any changes you make to the game options are saved when you exit the options screen.

PLAYING MODES

CHAMPIONSHIP

Confront your competitors or friends in 4 championships comprised of 3 different circuits, either in Single Player or Multi-Player.

At the end of each race, participants receive a number of points based on the order in which they finish. The driver who has scored the most points by the end of the last race wins the championship.

In single player championship mode only:

Your best scores are automatically saved for you to the MEMORY CARD (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) inserted in memory card slot 1.

SINGLE RACE

You can choose from 12 different courses to challenge your competitors or friends in frantic races. This mode is available in both single player and multiplayer.

CHASE RACE

Right from the start, the player is being pursued by Drones. The player must survive as long as possible on the circuit before his energy gauge runs out. The race ends when the energy bar is completely depleted.

TIME TRIALS *(available in Single Player only)*




This mode allows you to test your talents in driving alone against the track without opponents or bonuses. Time is your only competition. Your best times will be automatically saved on a MEMORY CARD (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) inserted in memory card slot 1.

BATTLE




In this mode, which is designed for Multiplayer only, confront one of your friends in the battle arenas. The rules are simple, the last one alive on the track wins! Each player starts with 3 lives. Bonuses are dispersed throughout each arena, enabling you to set traps for your opponent, or to attack them.

BONUSES









Bonuses are available and can be used in all playing modes except time trials. Bonuses will give you a serious advantage during your games.

	Power Up Coin This bonus will give you one power up for you to use at the most appropriate moment.
	Armor Coin These bonuses will repair your armor. They reappear during the race.
	Full Armor Bonus This bonus will restore all of your armor points.

POWER UP DEFENSE

	Drones The drones run around you and will protect you against your opponent's physical attacks.
	Shield The shield will protect you for a short while. You can use it when you are about to cross the finish line to make sure nothing bad can happen to you.
	Boost The boost will help you get out of problems and take a series positional advantage. It can be only used once and then its gone.

POWER UP WEAPONS

	<p>Bored Sphere It remains active throughout the race and disappears when someone touches it. To be touched, a vehicle must pass near it.</p>
	<p>Made-Up Sphere The two halves of the sphere split several yards apart and form a magnetic field that cuts across part of the track. It remains active throughout the race and disappears when someone touches it. To be touched, a vehicle must pass between the two demi-spheres.</p>
	<p>Missiles This is a set of 3 simple, yet efficient missiles. You will have to aim correctly when you shoot in order to hit your target. They simply shoot directly forward.</p>
	<p>Two-Split Spheres It has two horizontal slots where two blades come out and swirl around. It remains active throughout the race, and disappears when someone touches it. To be touched, vehicle must come fairly close to it.</p>
	<p>Toxic Cloud This weapon drops a toxic cloud. The cloud remains active throughout the race and disappears when someone passes through it.</p>
	<p>Magnet This weapon is based on a metallic plate that will slow down any vehicle that passes over or close to it. It remains active throughout the race and disappears after slowing a vehicle down.</p>
	<p>Mortar It is launched in a bell-shaped trajectory and can only hit a target that is at least 10 yards ahead and but no more than 30 yards. The projectile automatically targets an opponent that is inside the impact zone.</p>
	<p>Flash Light It is a powerful light that will blind the opponent just behind you for a short period of time. It only has one charge, so use it when the time is right!</p>

MINI GAMES

Try these two mini-games and beat the highscores!

Crazy Dance

Choose the music and the difficulty level with the left and right buttons.

Once the music starts, you must push the correct button at the right time to keep dancing.

As you continue to press the button correctly, the dancing will get faster and you'll trigger incredible combos!

Crazy Pinball

Choose the table you wish to start on and press X when you are ready.

It's now simple to control, just press X at the right moment, to launch the ball in the direction of the arrow. Try and eliminate all the drones for maximum bonus.
