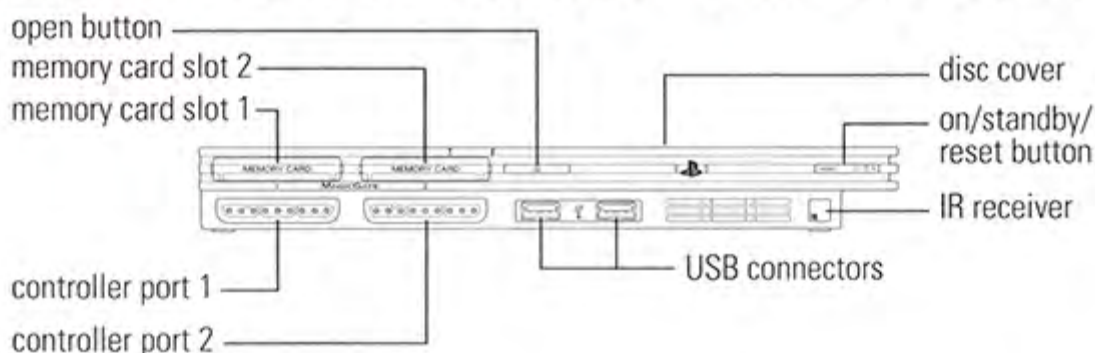

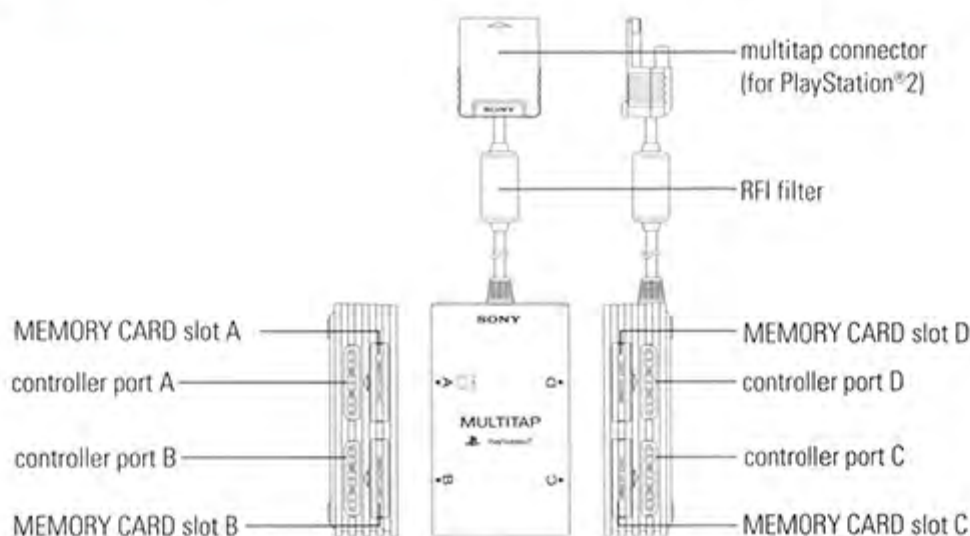

1. Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual.
2. Make sure the MAIN POWER switch (located at the back of the console) is turned ON.
3. Press the RESET button. When the power indicator lights up, press the OPEN button and the disc tray will open.
4. Place the *2006 FIFA World Cup™* disc on the disc tray with the label side facing up. Press the OPEN button again and the disc tray will close.
5. Attach game controllers and other peripherals, as appropriate.
6. Follow on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

NOTE: To enable Progressive Scan mode press and hold the  button and the  button on the language select screen with the desired language selected.

NOTE: When using the multitap (for PlayStation®2), a controller must be connected to controller port 1-A.



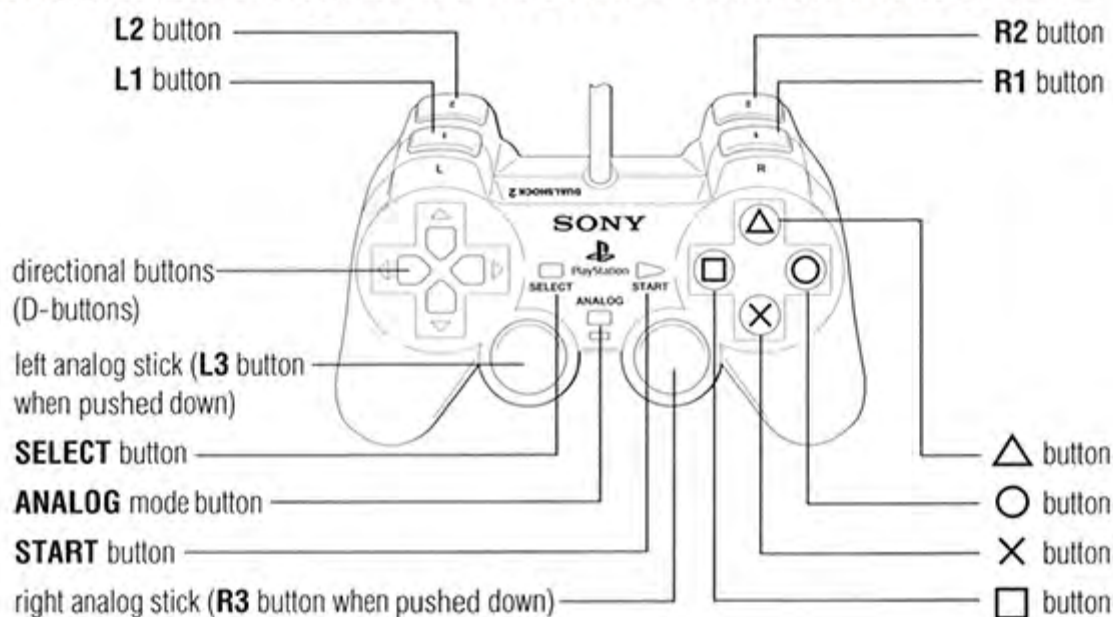

ADVANCED CONTROLS

GOALKEEPER

Move/Aim kick or throw	left analog stick
Throw	× button
Drop kick	□ button/○ button

SET PIECES

TAKING A DIRECT FREE KICK

Follow these steps to hit your intended target:

1. Press the left analog stick ←→ to aim your shot, and press the left analog stick ↕ to set the height of your kick.
2. To adjust the kicker's angle to the ball, press the right analog stick ←→. The greater the angle, the more spin is put on the ball.
3. To take the kick, press and hold the ○ button (or press and hold the × button for a short pass). The Kick Meter begins to fill.

NOTE: Take a driven shot (**L1** button + ○ button), choose a short pass to fool the defense (× button), or call a teammate to roll the ball to you (hold the **R2** button) in your pursuit of the goal.

4. Release the ○ button (or the × button) to kick or pass the ball, once the desired power is reached.

TAKING AN ATTACKING INDIRECT FREE KICK

- After setting your aim, press and hold the × button to pass, or press and hold the □ button to cross. You can also press and hold the **R2** button to have a teammate roll the ball to you (press and hold the ○ button to shoot, then release the ○ button to control the strength of the kick).

PLAYING THE GAME

Master your skills on the pitch in *2006 FIFA World Cup* to dominate your opponents on the biggest stage in sports.

PLAY NOW

Go straight onto the pitch and take on any country in the game. Before taking the pitch, be sure to press the  button at the Select Teams screen to view scouting reports.

TEAM MANAGEMENT

Tinker with your starting lineup, shake up your team, and find the winning formula. You can change players from any of the squads from around the world.


CREATION CENTRAL

Build a player from scratch—or edit players you've already created—and choose everything from his name and skin tone to his stats. You can have up to 16 created players in the game.

EDIT PLAYER

Edit any player from any country and access all of his personal attributes. Change players to suit your imagination or to match their real-life counterparts.

SQUAD MANAGEMENT

Choose which country's lineup you'd like to change, then determine which players among the starters and reserves should switch positions. Press the  button to view the Player Bio and make sure you have them where they can do the most damage.

ON THE PITCH

Get familiar with the on-screen icons, track your stamina, and master all the fundamentals in *2006 FIFA World Cup*.

PLAYER STATUS BAR



Fitness level/Playing style level

FITNESS LEVEL/PLAYING STYLE

During a match, a Player Status Bar appears at the bottom of the screen displaying the highlighted player's current level of fitness and playing style.

FITNESS

The fitness level decreases the more a player sprints, slowing him down, but replenishes when he returns to normal pace.

POWER, WEIGHT, AND DIRECTION

- When shooting or lobbing, a Power Meter appears at the bottom of the screen. Keep the kick or pass button pressed to increase power (elevation and distance) and release when the meter has filled sufficiently.

PASSING

- Through balls, passes, lobs, and crosses are automatically directed towards a teammate or a teammate's run (in the direction of the left analog stick).
- To play first-time balls (passing or shooting without first controlling the ball), press the pass or shoot button before the ball reaches your player.

DRIBBLING

- The faster you travel, the trickier it is to trap an incoming pass or keep control of the ball. Try to balance your pace with the need for control.
- Place your player between the ball and an opposing player to shield the ball and maintain possession.

SECONDARY DEFENDER

For the defender nearest the ball, tackling isn't always the best form of defense. When facing the man in possession, it's sometimes more effective to block his route to goal and then call in a secondary defender (**L1** button) to make the challenge.

TACTICS AND MENTALITY

Press the D-button to make tactical adjustments to your team's attack during the game and the **L1** button + D-button to change your defense.

Press the  button to show the current Team Mentality, then press the  button again to cycle through the mentalities (Neutral/All-Out Attack/Defensive).

NOTE: See the Tactics Help/Tips & Hints on the My FIFA World Cup menu for more detail.

SAVING


- To save files, choose the SAVE option from the relevant mode menu. You are also prompted to save files upon exiting certain screens.


NOTE: A memory card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) in MEMORY CARD slot 1 or MEMORY CARD slot 1-A when using a multitap (for PlayStation®2) is required to save data.

NOTE: Make sure you save regularly. Press the  button at the Main menu and in various modes to save your profile.

NOTE: Changes made outside individual game modes are applied in all game modes. Changes made within game modes are specific to that competition (except Game Settings).

LOADING

- Select a Profile upon boot-up to load previously saved game settings.
- To load a saved file *after* you've started the game, select LOAD from the My FIFA World Cup screen (or at the prompt when starting 2006 FIFA World Cup mode). Select a file and press the  button to load it.

NOTE: To view details on a file, highlight it and press the  button. This will help distinguish between multiple save files.








GAME MODES

Leave a lasting impression on the competition by participating in one of the many entertaining game modes in *2006 FIFA World Cup*.

NOTE: Most of the Game Modes in *2006 FIFA World Cup* are self explanatory and are not covered in this manual. Exceptions are listed below. Also see *Hints and Tips* on p. 8 for further information on playing the game.

2006 FIFA WORLD CUP QUALIFIERS/FINALS

Choose a team to control throughout the demanding home and away legs of the qualification rounds. At the end of a long road the glittering prize awaits—FIFA World Cup Finals. Capture the ultimate trophy and bring the FIFA World Cup back to the country of your choosing.

- At the Select Tournament Teams screen, press the D-button  to choose a group and then press the D-button  for the countries you want to be user controlled.
- When the draw is displayed, press the  button/ button to randomly redo the draw. To swap teams between groups, highlight a team and press the  button to select it. Then select a second team and press the  button so that both squads are selected. When the teams are set, press the  button to begin the tournament.

STORE

Unlock kits, players, and more by spending hard earned points in the FIFA Store. As you progress through the game and overcome each challenge, you are awarded points that are added to your profile. Unlocked rewards can be activated in Play Now mode (see p. 4).

GLOBAL CHALLENGE

Soccer is a challenging game, but *2006 FIFA World Cup* rewards you every time you step on the pitch. To see what earns you points, select GLOBAL CHALLENGE from the Main menu. Win at least a Bronze medal on every challenge to unlock the FIFA World Cup Finals section.

NOTE: Track the number of points earned by selecting STORE from the My FIFA World Cup menu. You can view your total points in the top right of the screen.

NOTE: Earn points by completing objectives select OBJECTIVES from the My FIFA World Cup menu to see what you need to achieve.

NOTE: Objectives are not awarded to a player when both teams are controlled by a player in a multiplayer game.

THE LOUNGE

Play against friends and separate contenders from pretenders as you determine the king of the pitch. Up to eight players compete to take top spot on the leaderboard.

- From Winner Stays On to Best vs. Worst, press the **L1** button/**R1** button to choose the match type that will ensure everyone gets in.

Play With Current Teams	Start a Lounge game with the countries already selected.
Play With Different Teams	Start a Lounge game with different countries.
Change Matchup Teams	Select different sides (Home/Away) and your kits.
Leaderboard	Check the leaderboard to see who's come in first and who's chasing the competition on points, wins, goals, and more.

HINTS AND TIPS

FIRST TOUCH

Press the right analog stick to control your first touch before you receive a pass to control the ball in that direction. Many new skill moves are also available when running or sprinting with the ball.

DEFENSE

Get close to the ball carrier (left analog stick) to battle for the ball without fouling.

SHOOTING

Use a chip shot (**L1** button + **○** button) to lift the ball over the keeper.

Put a bit of variety into your penalty kicks by chipping the keeper (**L1** button + **○** button).

DUMMY

Use a dummy (tap the **L2** button before receiving the ball) to let the ball go past, then turn and control it on the run. To let the ball go through to a teammate, hold the **L2** button before receiving the ball.
