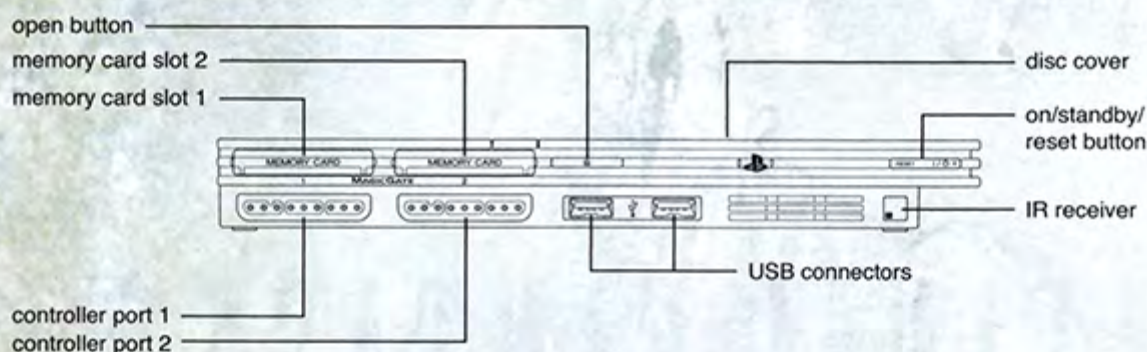

# GETTING STARTED



**Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green). Insert the FINAL FANTASY XI: WINGS OF THE GODDESS disc in the system with the label side facing up. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.**

If the PlayOnline Viewer is already installed on your HDD, you can start it up directly from the FINAL FANTASY XI: Wings of the Goddess expansion disc. There is no need to remove the disc after installation is complete.

## **NOTE: MOVIE SCENE SOUND**

This game contains Dolby® Digital 5.1 surround sound during select movie scenes. Connect your PlayStation®2 system to a sound system with Dolby Digital surround sound using a digital optical cable. Your sound system will automatically detect Dolby Digital during select movie scenes. If it does not, please refer to your sound system's instruction manual. You need to enable "Dolby Digital 5.1" in the audio options menu of the game. The audio from the analogue stereo cables of the PlayStation may be disabled during Dolby Digital.

# BASIC CONTROLS

## DUALSHOCK®2 ANALOG CONTROLLER CONFIGURATIONS



<b>directional buttons</b>	Select or change target / Move pointer
<b>left analog stick</b>	Move character
<b>L3 button</b>	When no target selected, heal (recover HP/MP) / When target selected, lock on to target
<b>R3 button</b>	Switch between first-person and third-person viewpoints
<b>right analog stick</b>	Move viewpoint
<b>× button</b>	Confirm; Select closest target or talk to NPC / When no target selected, open the action command window
<b>○ button</b>	Cancel / When in first-person view, hold down while character is moving to move side-to-side (strafe) / Delete one line of the log window each time it is pressed
<b>△ button</b>	Select active window, or optional commands for each window
<b>□ button</b>	Open main menu
<b>L1 button</b>	When pressed while character is moving, toggles "autorun" (press again to cancel; during autorun, use left analog stick to control movement as usual)
<b>R1 button</b>	Open the software keyboard
<b>L2 button</b>	Open macro palette 1
<b>R2 button</b>	Open marco palette 2
<b>START button</b>	Quit FINAL FANTASY XI and return to the title screen; when entering text using the analog controller, pressing the START button, after entering a letter in the input window, displays a list of common words and phrases used in FINAL FANTASY XI
<b>SELECT button</b>	Hide all windows; when pressed again, show the windows again

<b>[Esc]</b>	Cancel
<b>[Space bar]</b>	Open the input window for text entry
<b>[+] on the numeric keypad</b>	Selects active window, and allows setting of options for each window

[7] on the numeric keypad	When pressed while character is moving, toggles autorun
[Shift]	Allows character to strafe while moving in first-person perspective
[Page Up] or [9] on the numeric keypad	Zoom in
[Page Down] or [3] on the numeric keypad	Zoom out
[Home]	Return to default viewpoint

## COMMAND SHORTCUTS FOR USB KEYBOARDS

Various command shortcuts are available when using a USB keyboard. Combining these shortcuts with text commands will allow for smoother gameplay.

[F1]-[F6]	Target party members in the order that they appear in the window in the bottom right area of the screen
[F1]	Target yourself
[F8]	Target the closest NPC ("non-player character"; a character controlled by the computer)
[F9]	Target the closest PC ("player character"; a character controlled by another player)
[F10]	Target the first character in your party's member list
[F11], [F12]	When you are part of an alliance, target the first character in each allied party's member list
[Ctrl], [Alt]	Open a menu containing user-defined macros; hold down [Ctrl] or [Alt] and press the corresponding macro number to execute the macro

## PLAYONLINE VIEWER UPDATE

The FINAL FANTASY XI: Wings of the Goddess expansion disk contains an updated version of the PlayOnline Viewer and Tetra Master, which includes all updates as of July 2007. Please use this version if you need to reinstall the PlayOnline Viewer.

### Reinstalling the PlayOnline Viewer

1. Start up the PlayOnline Viewer from the FINAL FANTASY XI: Wings of the Goddess expansion disc.
  2. At the login screen, select "Install," then select "PlayOnline Viewer."
  3. Select "Reinstall Software" from the disc menu that appears
  4. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation process.
- You only have to reinstall the PlayOnline Viewer if it will not start up properly or other problems occur.
  - The FINAL FANTASY XI: Wings of the Goddess package does not include a PlayOnline registration code. You cannot use this disc to register a new PlayOnline account.



# INSTALLING AND REGISTERING

PlayOnline, FINAL FANTASY XI, FINAL FANTASY XI: Rise of the Zilart, FINAL FANTASY XI: Chains of Promathia, and FINAL FANTASY XI: Treasures of Aht Urhgan must be installed before you install FINAL FANTASY XI: Wings of the Goddess. Your macros and map marker data will not be lost when you install the expansion data.

## INSTALLING AND REGISTERING

1. Turn on your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system, insert the FINAL FANTASY XI: Wings of the Goddess expansion disc into the disc tray, and start PlayOnline. When the PlayOnline title screen appears, press any button on the analog controller or the USB keyboard to go to the menu screen.
2. Move the pointer to the "Install" selection on the menu and press the confirm button (i.e. the **X** button on the analog controller or the [Enter] key on the USB keyboard). Then select "FFXI: Wings of the Goddess" and press the confirm button again. Follow the on-screen instructions to proceed with the installation process.
3. Once installation is complete, you need to restart your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system. There is no need to remove the disc after installation is complete.
4. Log into PlayOnline, select "Content ID" from the FINAL FANTASY XI top page, and press the confirm button.
5. At the Content ID screen, select "Register ID" from the "Expanded Services" menu and press the confirm button. Please read the "About Expanded Services" section before registering.
6. Enter your PlayOnline ID and PlayOnline password at the Log In screen.
7. On the Expanded Services Registration screen, select "FFXI: Wings of the Goddess," then enter your Wings of the Goddess registration code shown on the last page of this instruction manual.
  - You must enter a valid Wings of the Goddess registration code to complete the registration process.
8. A confirmation screen will appear. Select "Exit" to proceed. You will now be able to access the content included in FINAL FANTASY XI: Wings of the Goddess.

- **Please keep your registration code in a safe place.**

The expanded services registration code allows one PlayOnline ID to access expanded services. Once you register your PlayOnline ID for expanded services, all Content IDs (characters) can access these expanded services. This applies to future Content IDs (characters) as well. (i.e. You only have to register the Wings of the Goddess expansion once.) There is no need to repeat this for each character Content ID you purchase.)

- A PlayOnline ID, password, and an expanded services registration code are required to register for expanded services. Even if you have installed the expansion data, you cannot access expanded services until you complete the registration process.
- Once you have registered Wings of the Goddess, it cannot be removed.
- There is no additional fee for registering a Wings of the Goddess Content ID.

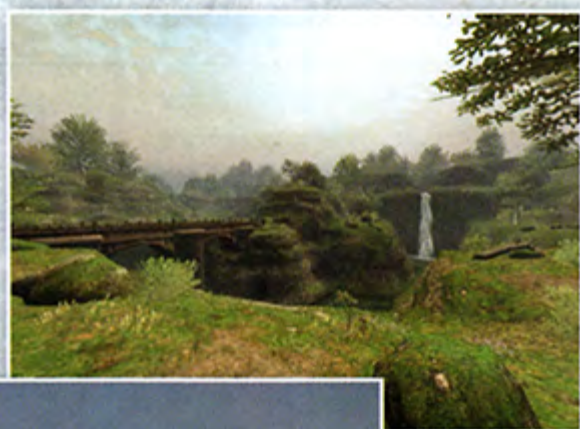
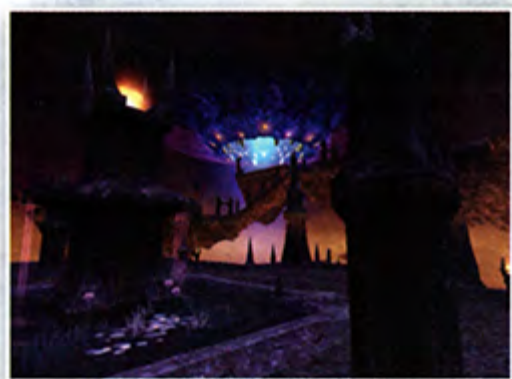
### Cavernous Maw

# BACKGROUND





## Campaign



This is the collective term given to the series of battles and border skirmishes waged in the Quon and Mindartian theaters during the Crystal War.

All those wishing to serve would enlist with one of the allied army's three main forces—the Kingdom of San d'Oria, the Republic of Bastok, or the Federation of Windurst—to combat the ever-advancing beastmen confederate comprising the Quon Host of the Orcish Empire, the Quadav Shieldwarriors, the Yagudo Theomilitary, and the Shadowlord's Dark Kindred.
