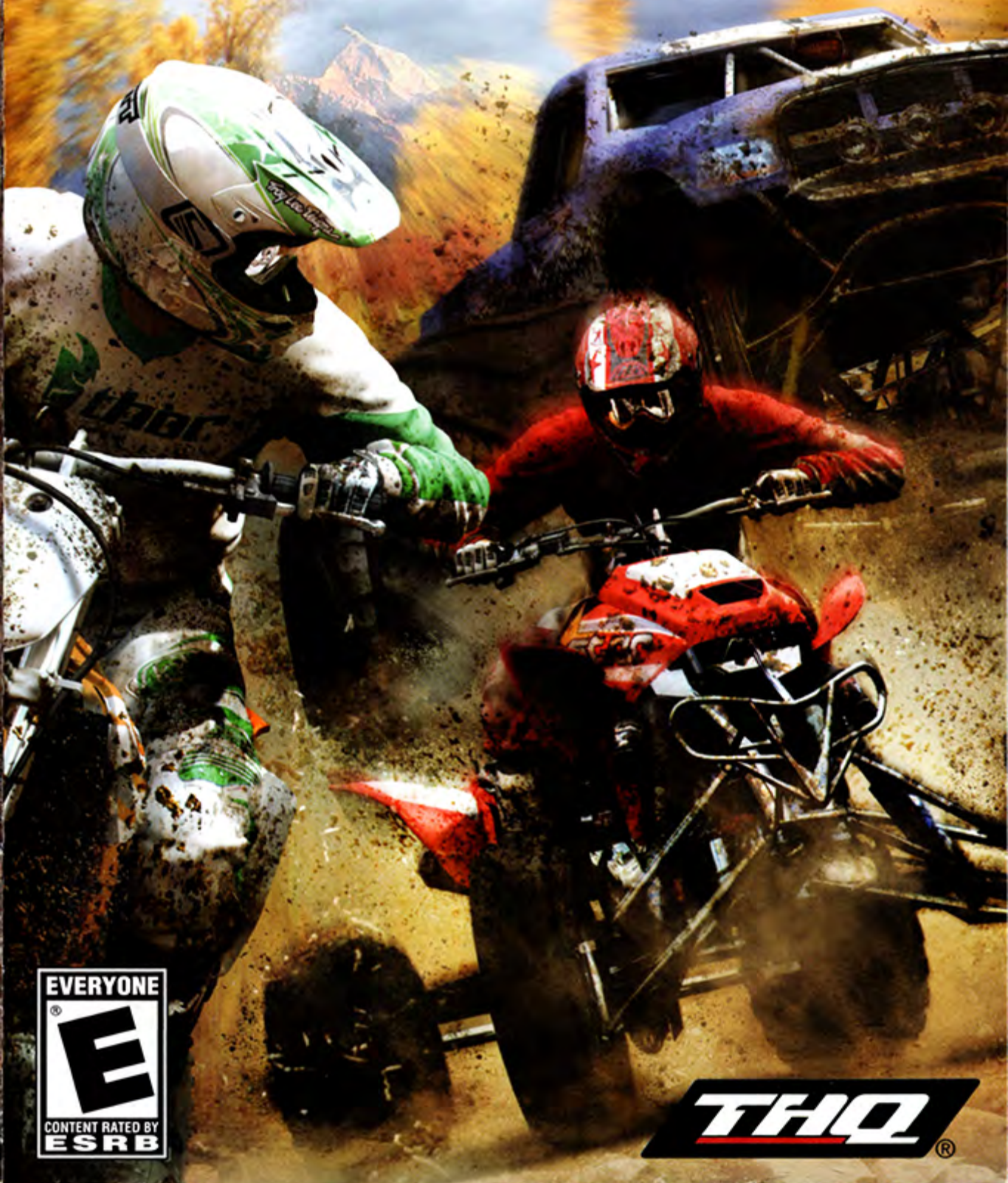

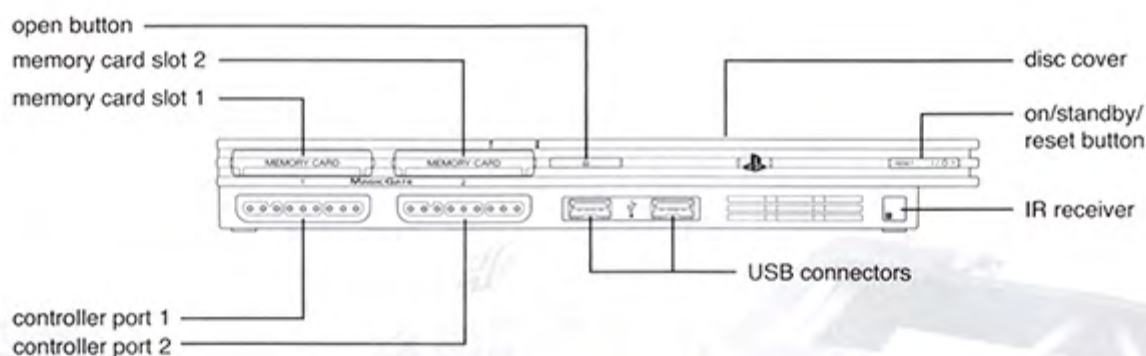
- This disc is intended for use only with PlayStation 2 consoles with the NTSC U/C designation.

SETTING UP YOUR PLAYSTATION®2 CONSOLE

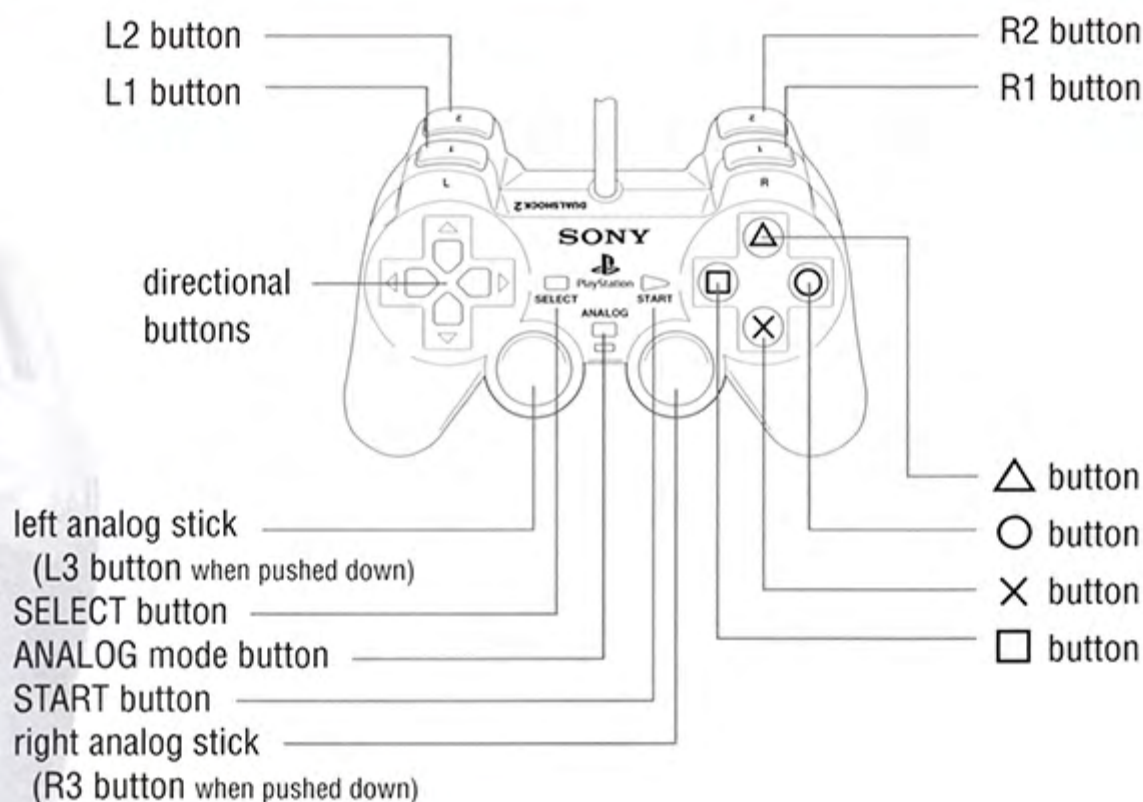
Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green). Insert the **MX vs ATV Untamed** disc in the system with the label side facing up. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

MEMORY CARD (8MB) (FOR PLAYSTATION®2)

To save game settings and progress, insert a memory card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) into MEMORY CARD slot 1 of your PlayStation®2 system. You can load saved game data from the same memory card or any memory card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2) containing previously saved games.

THE GAME SCREEN



- ① **Stunt Score:** This is the total score for successfully completed stunts.
- ② **Lap:** Indicates which lap you're currently on.
- ③ **Position:** See your position among the total racers and view rider position by name.
- ④ **Map:** Top view of your position, with the yellow triangle representing you. Opponents are white circles.
- ⑤ **Time:** This is your current lap time.
- ⑥ **Best:** Your best lap time for the current race.
- ⑦ **Speedometer:** Displays your speed and gear position.






Lead: See how you are leading or trailing in the race by time.

Stunt in Progress: During execution of stunts, the stunt name and possible points appear on-screen. These points are added to the Stunt Score. If the stunt isn't completed successfully the stunt name and score will turn red, and no points will be awarded.

STARTING A NEW GAME

MAIN MENU



Press the  button at the Title Screen to be taken to the Main Menu. Use the directional buttons  and  to highlight a game mode or option and press the  button to confirm. To go back or return to a higher set of options, press the  button.

SINGLE PLAYER

Tackle the world of MX and ATV in various events and tournaments that include QUICK RACE, X-CROSS, CHAMPIONSHIP, and GAPS. The more you compete and win, the more vehicles and other goodies will become unlocked. This is where the training wheels come off and you become an off-road champ.

MULTIPLAYER

Select SPLIT SCREEN for two people to play on the same system simultaneously via a split screen, or choose ONLINE to go online and race against the best of the online community.

STORE

Head over to the Store to purchase new vehicles and gear.

OPTIONS

Manage your profile and adjust the game options. For more information, see Options, pg. 12.

Note: Playing without a Profile will result in any progress, achievements, collectibles, preferences, or changes you make being lost.

SINGLE PLAYER

Select SINGLE PLAYER from the Main Menu. Use the directional buttons ← and → to select a racing event and press the ⊗ button to confirm your selection.

QUICK RACE

Jump right into the fray for the quickest way to MX and ATV action. Event Type, Racing Track, and Vehicle Type can be selected. Press the ◻ button to randomize the game options. When you're ready, press the ⊗ button to begin the game.

X-CROSS TOURNAMENT

Master the controls of each vehicle and the rhythm of every course as each new series tests your mettle among them. Rewards abound as you make your way through the Divisions to receive your trophy at the end. Along the way, each series offers new opportunities for victory and even more opportunities for defeat, including new event types and the infamous "Challenges". This is where you can unlock new gear, vehicles, cash, and even pro-riders—that is, if you can compete against the best on all levels in every type of event. Use the directional buttons to highlight a series and press the ⊗ button to confirm your choice.

CUSTOM EVENT

Fully customize your challenge in any event type. Consider this area as the training ground to master all the different events and rides before moving on to competing in official tournaments.

Choose the track, then move on to the Event Options Menu and select the Race Mode, Difficulty, number of Laps, number of Opponents, Vehicle type, and Vehicle Class. Once finalized, press the ⊗ button to continue to the next menu where you can select the Vehicle Group. Press the ⊗ button to begin the game.

NATIONALS

Outdoor, lap-based racing courses cast in beautifully detailed environments. Less technical and more about top speed, these races are prone to big jumps and significant rhythm sections.

SUPERCROSS

Considered to be where the best riders compete, Supercross pushes your skills the hardest in these stadium-based locations where the tracks are more technical in nature.

SUPERMOTO

Paved road-courses mark the way for both MX and ATV riders to compete against each other. These courses have plenty of twists and turns to make you succumb to the competition.

OPENCROSS

Race through treacherous outdoor trails against various types of vehicles – big and small. To win, you must master the environments before the environments master you.

FREESTYLE

It's all about pulling off the most difficult tricks in succession to gain first place. Choose a Freestyle Mode before selecting the other event options.

FREE RIDE

Feel free to explore the world and hunt for hidden and hard to get sprockets within the environment.

WAYPOINT

Instead of cones and stakes outlining a specific route, there's only the expansive outdoors and key waypoint gates to mark your way to the finish.

OPEN CLASS

Feel the wind whip through your hair as you ride a series of difficult outdoor tracks and challenge all classes of vehicles.

HILL CLIMB

Become king of the hill in this race to the top.

CHALLENGES



Put your skills to the test with various Challenges in this section. Come out on top and you'll be rewarded with sweet swag. Just select a Challenge and you're off and riding.

CHAMPIONSHIP

Championship Competition across 12 tracks awaits you in the Championships. Your race position for each track is combined to determine your overall standing for the week. Gain the highest standing across all 12 weeks to be declared the Champ. First select the Event Type, and then choose the Championship Type.

If it is the first week of the Championship, you will need to also select the Opponent Difficulty, number of Laps per race, and Vehicle Class. Remember that these selections cannot be changed after the first week of competition.

GAPS

Ride free and explore the open landscape where you can find hidden jumps and runs! First select the track and then press the  button to continue to the next screen. There you will choose the race mode, difficulty, duration, vehicle type and vehicle class. Then press the  button to begin riding.

RECORDS

Check your progress and ability by selecting an Event type, Track, and Record type. The top three scores for your selection are shown underneath. Whenever you get a better score or lap time, these Records will upgrade, showing everyone how seriously you know how to ride!



MULTIPLAYER

(SPLITSCREEN & NETWORK)

Up to two can play on Split Screen while up to six people can compete at once on Network. QUICK EVENT and CUSTOM EVENT are available for both Split Screen and Network.

Log in to Network play by first setting up a Network Configuration. Then enter your Gamespy Network information, such as Username, Email, and Password. Or if you do not have an ID, you can create one here.

QUICK EVENT

Jump right into the fray for the quickest way to MX and ATV action. Event Type, Event Duration, Vehicle Class, and Vehicle Type are all randomized so you don't have to sit through the selection process. Press the  button to reshuffle the game options, and then when you're ready, press the  button to begin the game.

CUSTOM EVENT



Fully customize your challenge in any event type. The events include: Free Ride, National, Supercross, Freestyle, Opencross, Supermoto, Waypoint.

GAMESPY NETWORK

Up to six people can compete at once in either QUICK MATCH or CREATE MATCH.

Note: MX vs. ATV requires a Profile for online play.

QUICK MATCH

Here is instant access to MX and ATV Untamed action. Event Type, Event Duration, Vehicle Class, and Vehicle Type are all randomized so you don't have to sit through the selection process. Press the  button to reshuffle the game options, and then press the  button to begin the game.

CREATE MATCH

Create a match and join others to play your creation. First select the session type, vehicle type, and number of players. Then press the **X** button and continue to the next menu where you select your personal vehicle type, class, and physics type. Press the **X** button again to select the event type, then move on to select the event, and next the track. Last is the number of laps. Press the **X** button to head off to the races.

SEARCH

Search for a specific event based on number of players, event, or track.

BUDDY LIST

See how your online friends are doing. Here you can check their online status.

SCOREBOARDS

Check your stats and high scores and compare your scores to others from around the globe in the WORLD BEST SCORES section. Here you can also reset your scores.

LOG OFF

Log off online play and return to the Multiplayer Menu.

STORE

Visit the store to purchase new ATVs, MX Bikes, Gear, Machines, and all new Environments!

OPTIONS

Select **OPTIONS** from the Main Menu. Use the directional buttons **↑** and **↓** to highlight the option and press the **ⓧ** button to confirm your selection.

Note: Default Options are in bold.

PROFILE

Create, Load, Save, or Delete a profile in order to track your achievements or get rid of any unwanted Profiles. You can also check the Game Stats of any Profile currently in session.

CONTROL SETTINGS

Toggle the controller layout between Control 1 and Control 2.

GAME SETTINGS

Adjust various game settings such as Split Screen Horizontal/Vertical, Ecosystem Collision ON/OFF, and Display Mode 480p/480i, among others.

SCREEN ADJUSTMENT

Adjust the screen placement within your television's dimensions.

AUDIO OPTIONS

Adjust the Sound Configuration, and choose between Audio Presets depending on your listening preferences, or customize them yourself.

JUKEBOX

Explore the game's list of songs, with the option to Play them right out of the Jukebox, or Toggle them between playing or not playing during the game.

CREDITS

View the game's Credits.

PAUSE MENU

At anytime during a game, press the  button to go to the Pause Menu. From here, you'll be able to choose from a number of options.

ACTIVITY OPTIONS

Here you adjust the Mode of game play, the Number of Opponents, the Opponent Difficulty level, and the Number of Laps.

SWITCH ACTIVITY

Select the type of Activity you are racing in.

QUIT ACTIVITY

Quit the current Activity and return to the Main Menu.

OVERLAY OPTIONS

Here you can toggle ON/OFF what appears on the game screen.

CONTROL OPTIONS

Enable or Disable the Vibration function.

JUKEBOX

Choose your favorite music to play while working your way toward first place.

AUDIO PRESETS

Select an audio mix setting to rock out to. These mixes set the audio levels for Music, Crown, Engine, Sound Fx, Menu Fx, and Menu Music automatically.



SWITCH EVENT

Change out of the Event you are currently in for a different Event. You can also change the track, Vehicle, Opponent Vehicles, Bike Class, and Physics Type.

RETURN TO MAIN MENU

Quit your game and return to the Main Menu.

QUIT EVENT

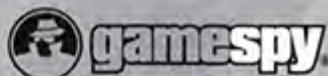

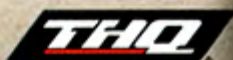
