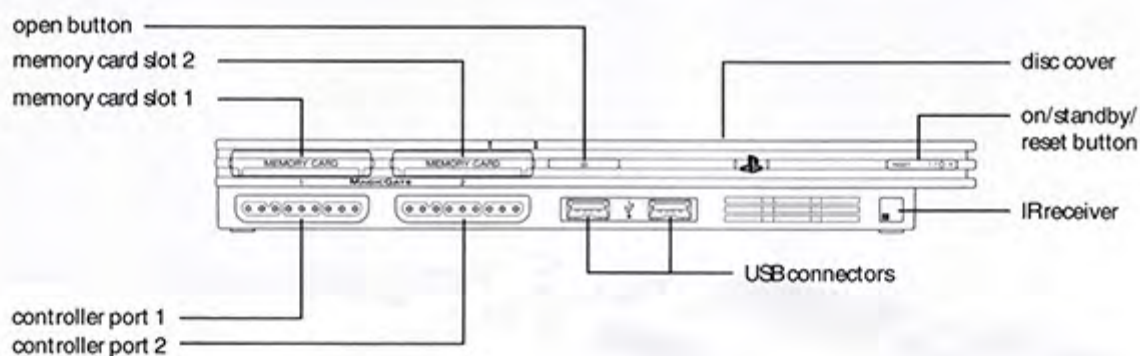
HANDLING YOUR PLAYSTATION 2 FORMAT DISC:

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GETTING STARTED*



Set up your PlayStation(R)2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green). Press the OPEN button to open the disc cover. Place the SnoCross 2 disc with the label side facing up in the disc holder, and then close the disc cover. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

Memory Card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2)

To save game settings and progress, insert a memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2) into MEMORY CARD slot 1 of your PlayStation®2 system. You can load saved game data from the same memory card or any memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2) containing previously saved games.

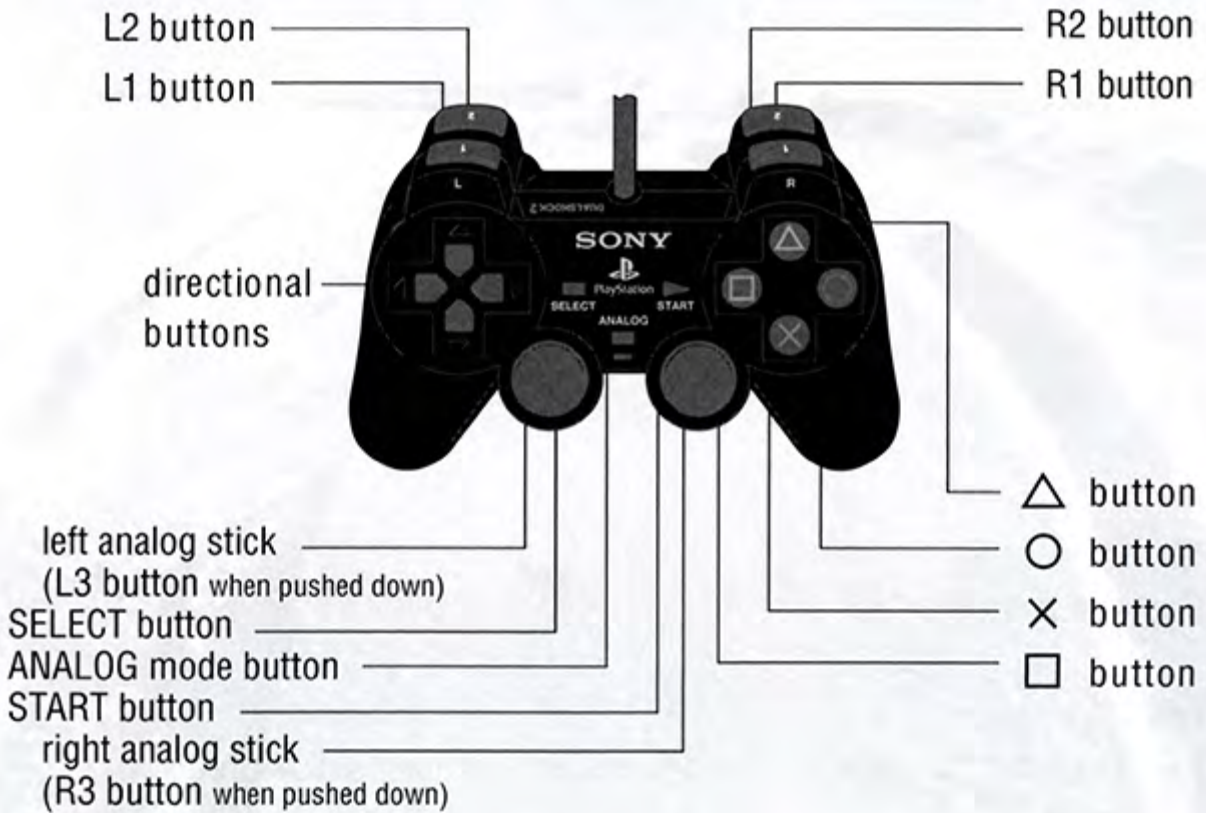

STARTING UP THE GAME

Press the START button at any time during or after the SnoCross 2 opening movie.

Main Menu

The Main Menu is the central access point for all of the game's modes and options.

Quick Race

Engage in a quick race

Multiplayer

Race head-to-head with your friends in 2 player split screen.

Career

Put your skills to the test as you battle to dominate the field through a full career.

Create-A-Track

Build your own track to race on.

STARTING A SINGLE PLAYER QUICK RACE

To start a single player quick race:

1. Highlight the QUICK RACE option and press the \times button. The RACE SETTINGS screen will appear.
2. At any time while on the RACE SETTINGS screen press the \times button to begin the race with the currently selected settings. The \triangle button can be pressed to return you to the MAIN MENU.
3. Pressing up or down on the directional buttons while on the RACE SETTINGS screen will move the selecting highlight up and down over the available settings. Pressing left or right on the directional buttons while on a highlighted setting will cycle through that setting's options.
4. When all settings are set to their desired options press the \times button to begin the race.

RACE SETTINGS SCREEN

Rider Select

Pressing the left or right directional buttons will cycle through the available riders. Additional riders can be unlocked by playing through the career mode.

Sled Select

Pressing the left or right directional buttons will cycle through the available sleds. Additional sleds can be unlocked by playing through the career mode.

Track

Pressing the left or right directional buttons will cycle through the available race tracks.

Objective

Pressing the left or right directional buttons will cycle through the following game modes: Circuit, Bowling, Rally, Trick Attack, and Elimination.

AI Players

Pressing the left or right directional buttons will increase or decrease the number of AI controlled racers that will compete against you. There can be up to three additional riders (depending on the Objective you've chosen) or you can ride the track solo by selecting zero opponents.

Laps

Pressing the left or right directional buttons will increase or decrease the number of laps in the race. You can select between one and five laps, depending on the Objective you've chosen.

Begin Event

Begins the race or selected game type.

Info: The sled that you select will be one of the most important factors in determining if you'll dominate the pack or get left in the snow drift. Experiment with the sleds and pick one that matches your style of play.

ON THE RACE TRACK

HEADS UP DISPLAY

Score Box

The uppermost box on the left side of the screen is the Score Box. This box displays your current score as earned through tricks.

Total Time Clock

Just below the Score Box is the Total Time Clock. This clock tracks your total amount of time in the race.

Lead Clock

Just below the Total Time Clock is the Lead Clock. This timer informs you how far ahead of the pack you are or how many seconds you are behind the pack leader. If the clock is green then you are in the lead and the clock is displaying the time difference between you and the nearest rider. If the clock is red then you are trailing the pack leader by the time displayed.

Track Mini Map

The Track Mini Map is located in the bottom left corner of the screen. In addition to providing a visual reference to the layout of the track, it also shows you your current position and that of the other racers.

Position Box

The Position Box is the uppermost box on the right hand side. This box displays your current race position.

Lap Box

The Lap Box is located just below the Position Box and it displays what lap you are currently on relative to the number of laps that comprise the race.

Speedometer

The Speedometer is located in the bottom right hand corner of the screen. The Speedometer displays your current speed in miles-per-hour.

Boost Meter

The Boost Meter occupies the upper edge of the Speedometer display. The meter fills when you perform tricks. The longer the trick combo the more the meter fills.

Path Arrow

The path arrow is the blue arrow located in the center of the screen and slightly above your racer. This arrow points in the direction that you need to go. (It can be turned on and off from within the Options menu.)

TRICKS

To perform a trick:

1. Find a jump that will provide you with the big air you're going to need and accelerate toward it.
2. While in the air press and hold the ○ button and press any direction on the directional buttons or the left analog stick. You will perform a trick based on your control inputs. Experiment with pressing different directions to learn new tricks.

Info: Successfully performing tricks will add points to your score and increase your Boost Meter. Wisely using your Boost can make the difference between winning and losing.

TRICK LIST

- Button = No Footed Can Can
- Button + ↑ = Cliffhanger
- Button + ↓ = Heel Clicker
- Button + ← = Indian Air
- Button + → = Nac Nac
- Button + ↑→ = Rock Solid
- Button + →↓ = Heart Attack
- Button + ↓← = Shaolin
- Button + ←↑ = Double Seat Grab

Info: The longer you hold a trick the more points you will receive for completing it. Be careful though, if you don't land the trick you'll lose all points for attempting it. You'll also walk away with some bumps and bruises.

RIDER RESET

Occasionally you may find yourself in a difficult position to recover from. In cases where it is simply easier to reset your character rather than to struggle with realigning yourself you can press the SELECT button to reset your sled to the center of the track.

PAUSE MENU

Press the START button to pause the game.

Continue

This option will return you to gameplay.

Restart

This option will start the race over from the beginning.

Options

This will take you to the options menu.

Quit

This option will exit the current race and return you to the main menu.

OPTIONS MENU

Once in the OPTIONS MENU, press the up or down directional buttons to highlight options. Press the left or right directional buttons to adjust the value of the highlighted option.

Sound Volume

This option adjusts the volume of world and sound effects.

Music Volume

This option adjusts the volume of the game music.

Vibration

This option turns the vibrating functionality of the DUALSHOCK®2 controller on or off.

ADDITIONAL GAME MODES

BOWLING

The goal of bowling is to knock down as many pins as you can, just like the classic game, but there's a twist: YOU ARE THE BALL!

RALLY

Groups of bowling pins are scattered throughout the track. Take two laps around the circuit, knocking down as many pins as you can.

TRICK ATTACK

This is a time limited event. Hit the big jumps and pull off more tricks than your opponents to win.

ELIMINATION

Everyone races around the track, and the last player to finish each lap is kicked out of the race. The last racer left standing wins.

CREATE-A-TRACK

The Create-A-Track feature of SnoCross 2 allows you to create, save, and race tracks of your own.

To create your own track:

1. Highlight the CREATE-A-TRACK option on the main menu and press the \times button. This will take you to the CREATE-A-TRACK track editor.
2. Select track elements from the track templates on the right side of the screen by pressing the X button.
3. Press the \square Button to rotate a track section until it is facing the desired direction
4. Press the \times Button again to place the track object onto the grid.
5. Repeat steps 2 - 4 until you have completed your desired track.
6. Ensure that the end of your track connects with the start point of the track.
7. Test the track using the Test Track function in the lower right hand corner of the screen.

Info: The end of your created race tracks must connect with the start point of your track or the track will not function. Use the Test Track option located on the CREATE-A-TRACK editor to ensure that your track will function.
