

# Super PickUps™

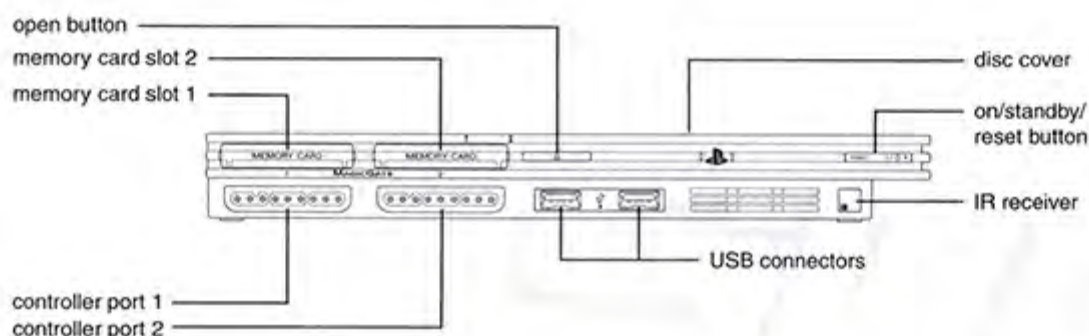
**HANDLING YOUR PLAYSTATION 2 FORMAT DISC:**

- This disc is intended for use only with PlayStation 2 consoles with the NTSC U/C designation.
- Do not bend it, crush it or submerge it in liquids.
- Do not leave it in direct sunlight or near a radiator or other source of heat.
- Be sure to take an occasional rest break during extended play.
- Keep this compact disc clean. Always hold the disc by the edges and keep it in its protective case when not in use. Clean the disc with a lint-free, soft, dry cloth, wiping in straight lines from center to outer edge. Never use solvents or abrasive cleaners.

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# GETTING STARTED



Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green). Insert the Super Pickups™ disc in the system with the label side facing up. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

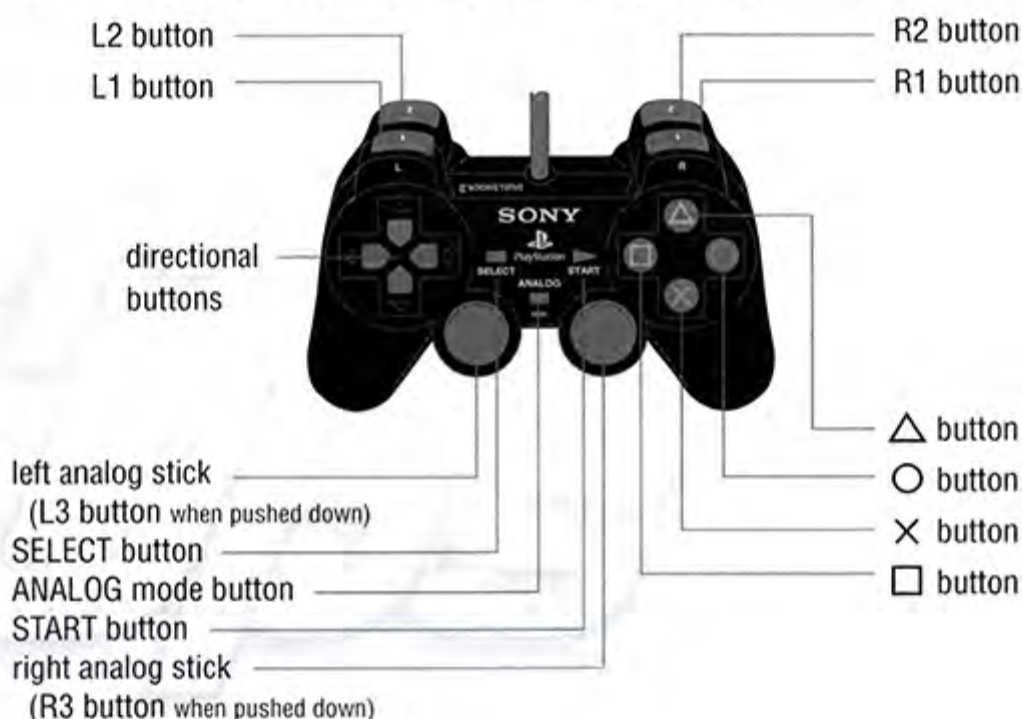
## Memory Card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2)

# GETTING STARTED

## FIRST START-UP

After having inserted your Super Pickups™ game disc into your console, Super Pickups™ initial screen will be displayed.

## IN-GAME MENU NAVIGATION

The navigation within the Super Pickups™ Menu is pretty simple and intuitive: by utilizing your analog controller (DUALSHOCK®2) directional buttons you can move upwards and downwards (and, where possible, to the right and to the left) among the various menu items. The  button is used to confirm your selection and the  button cancels your selection.

## CONTROLLER SETUP

Here you find several Controller configurations and settings to choose from.

- Controller port: Identify the controller you want to set up
- Vibration: turn the vibration function on/off
- Controller layout: choose from different profiles for the most suitable controller configuration

Here you can manage the following options:

## **DRIVER SELECTION**

Here you can select, create, edit, or delete driver profiles. In the beginning of the game when no profiles are stored in the memory card (8MB) (for PlayStation®2), you will only be able to create a New Driver profile.

### **NEW DRIVER**

Use the on-screen keyboard to choose Driver name. Use the left analog stick to move through the virtual keyboard. Press the **X** button to confirm a character. When you're done with the name, press the **X** button on the analog controller (DUALSHOCK®2) to proceed.

### **DELETE DRIVER**

Here you can select the profile to delete.

### **SAVE DRIVER**

Here you can save your current Driver profile. Select a slot and then confirm your choice pressing the **X** button.

## **UNLOCKING VEHICLES**

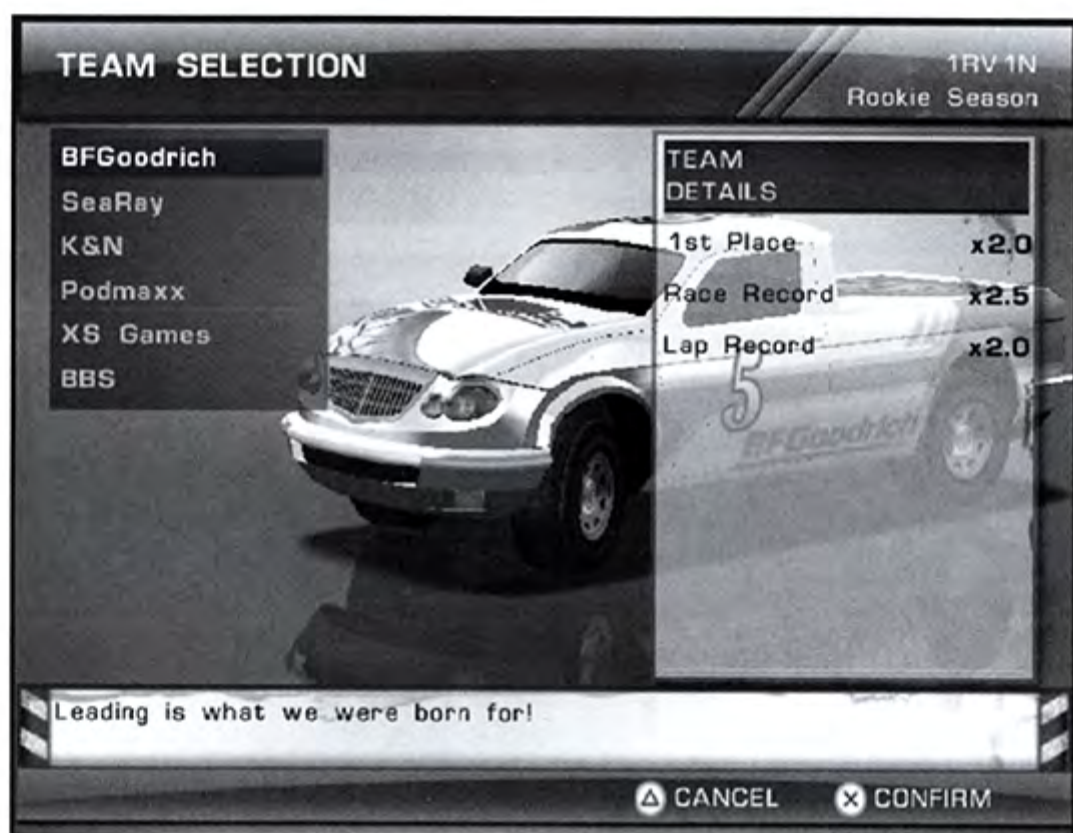
You can unlock vehicles by winning specific races and completing seasons in the Career Mode.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

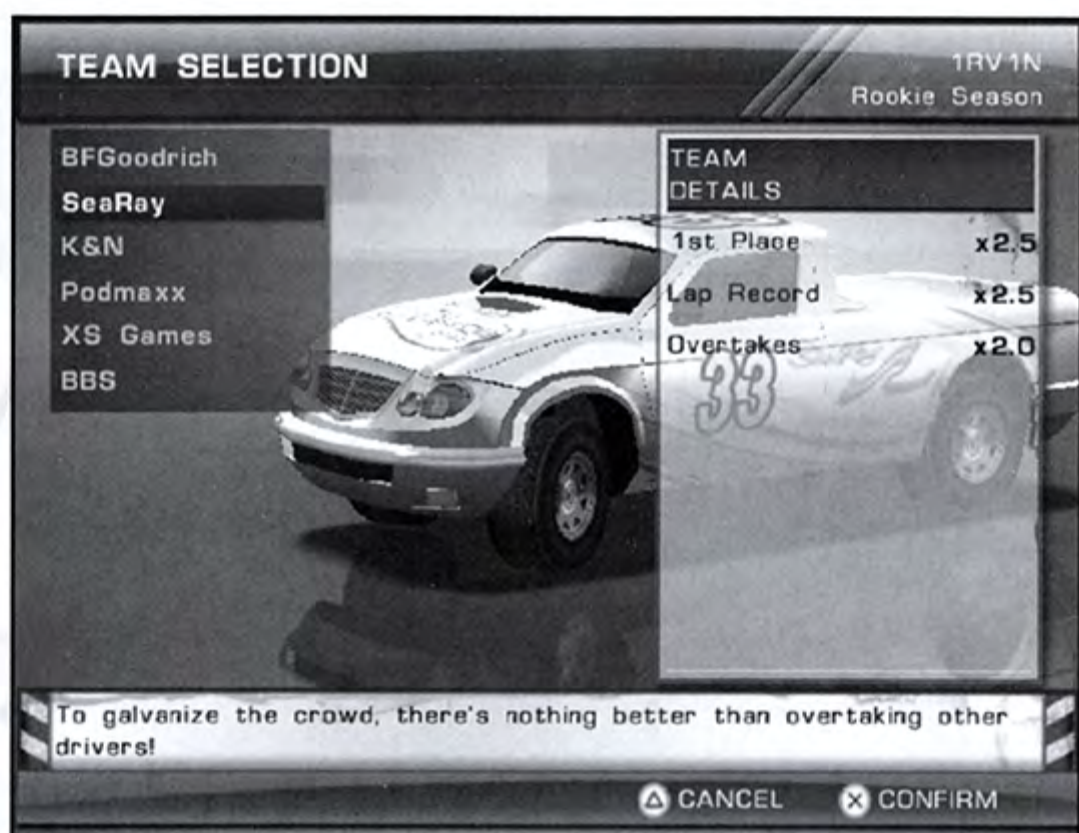
## BF Goodrich

**Overtakes:** The more cars you pass in a race, the more money you'll make!



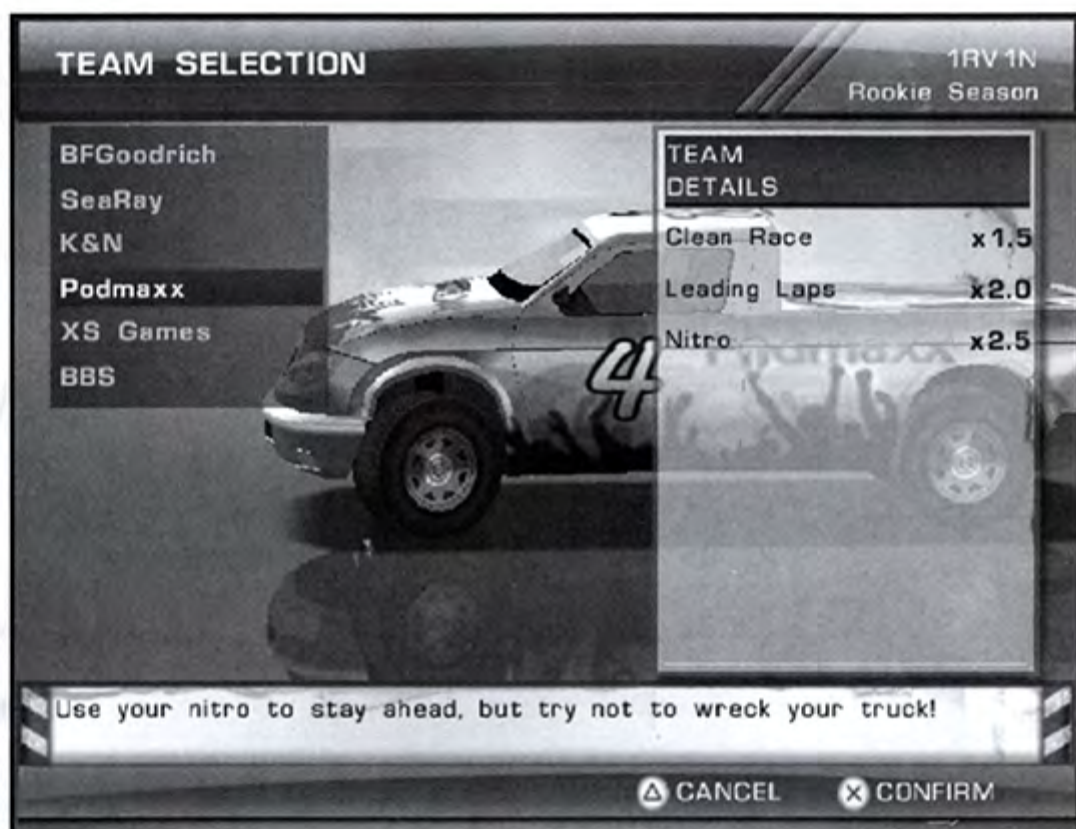


## K&N

**Clean Lap:** Complete a lap without hitting anyone, and earn some bonus cash.



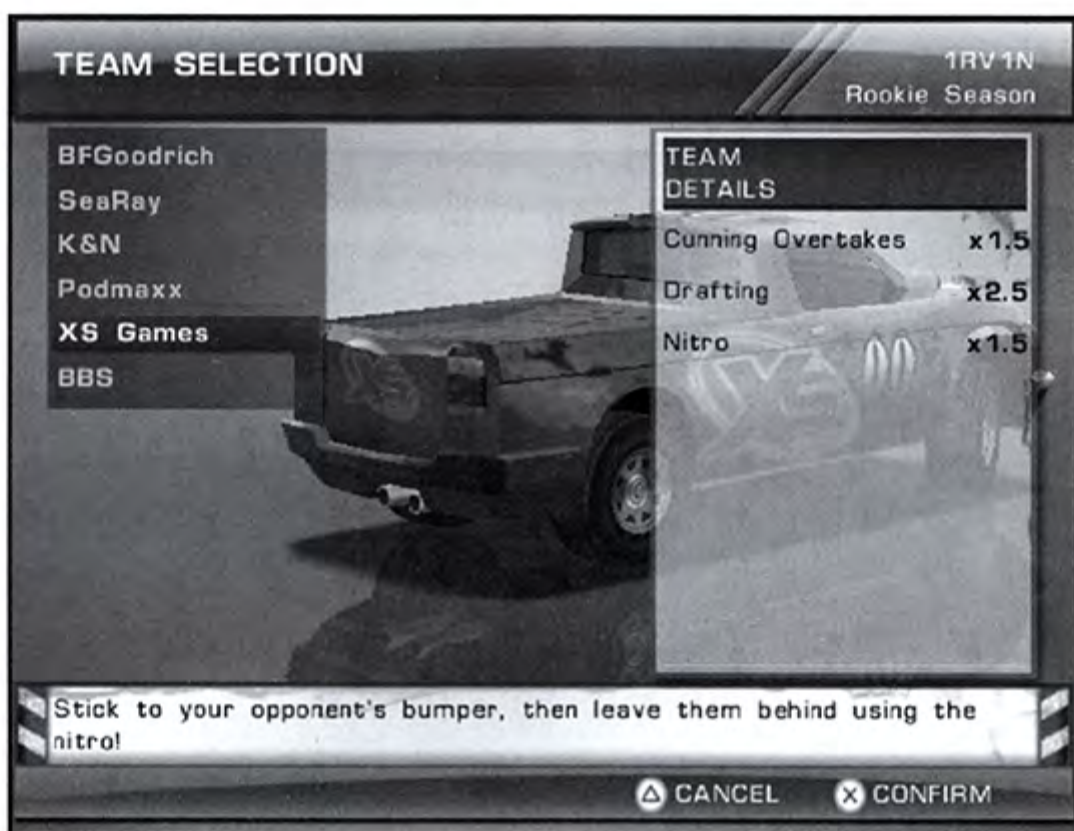
## PodMaxx

**Nitro:** Use your nitro boost as often as possible to earn bonus money.





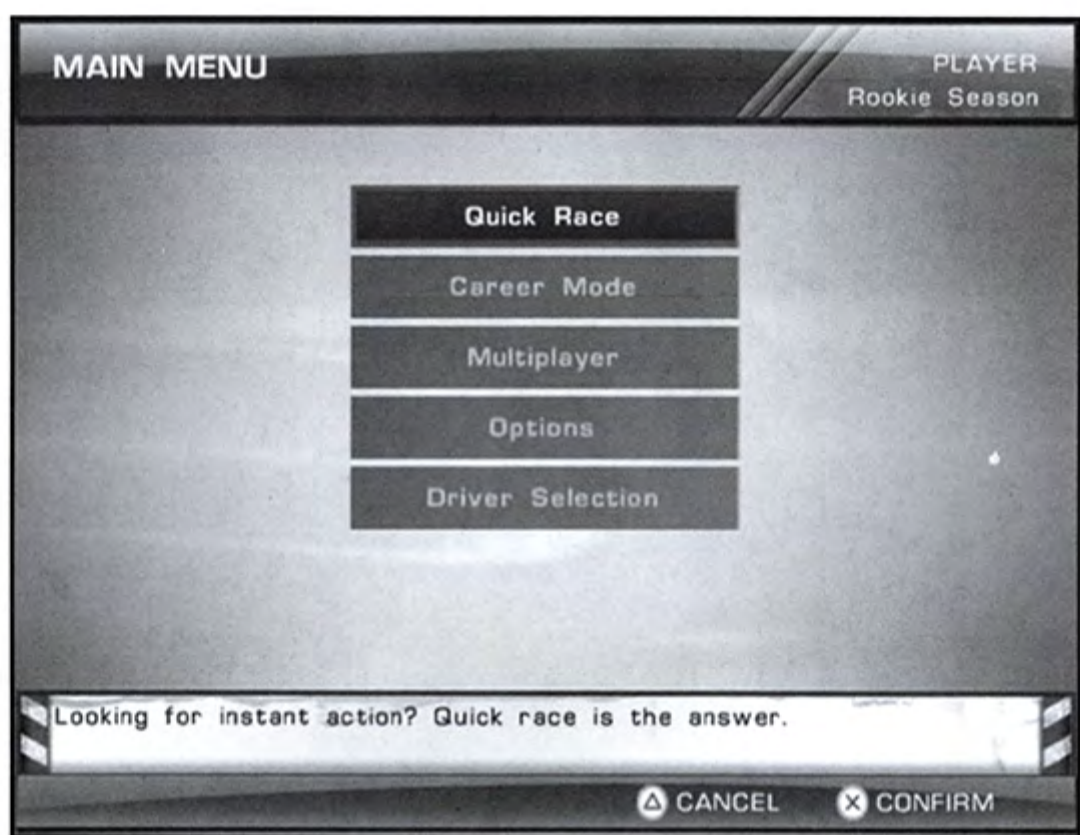
## BBS

**Car Condition:** Try to take as little damage as possible during a race. Take no damage for the best possible bonus.

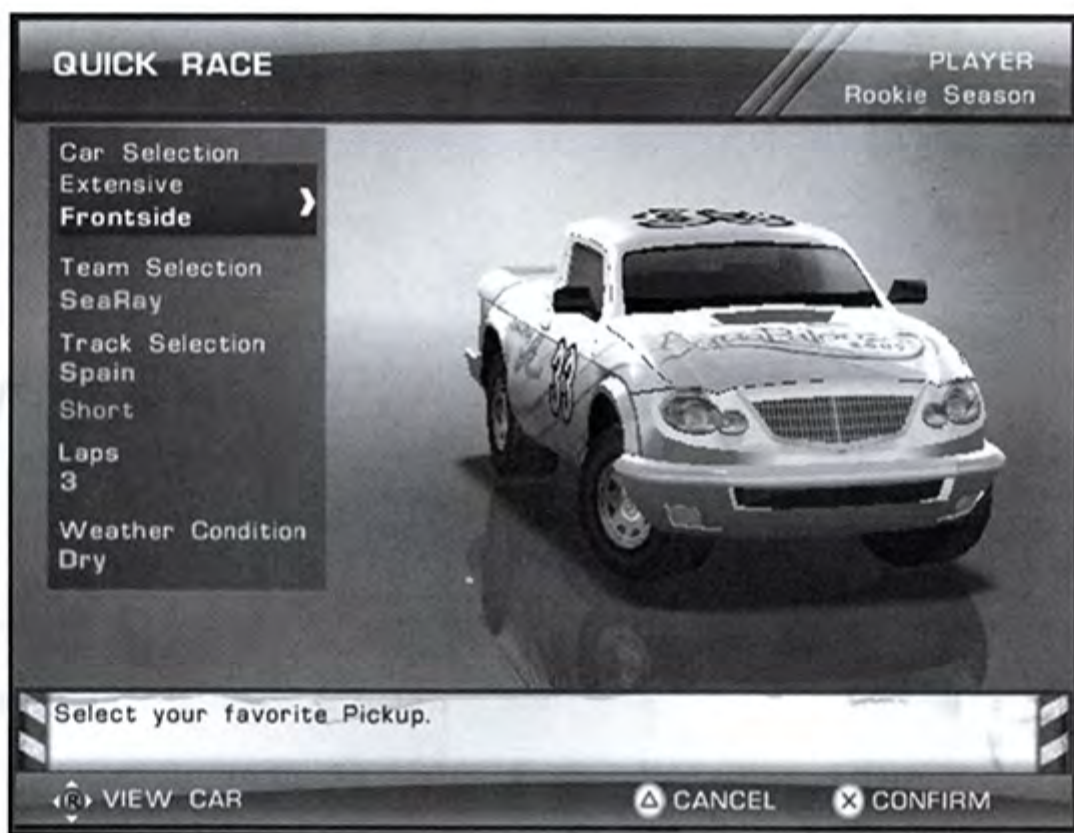
**No Nitro:** Keep your finger off the nitro for some extra cash.

## QUICK RACE

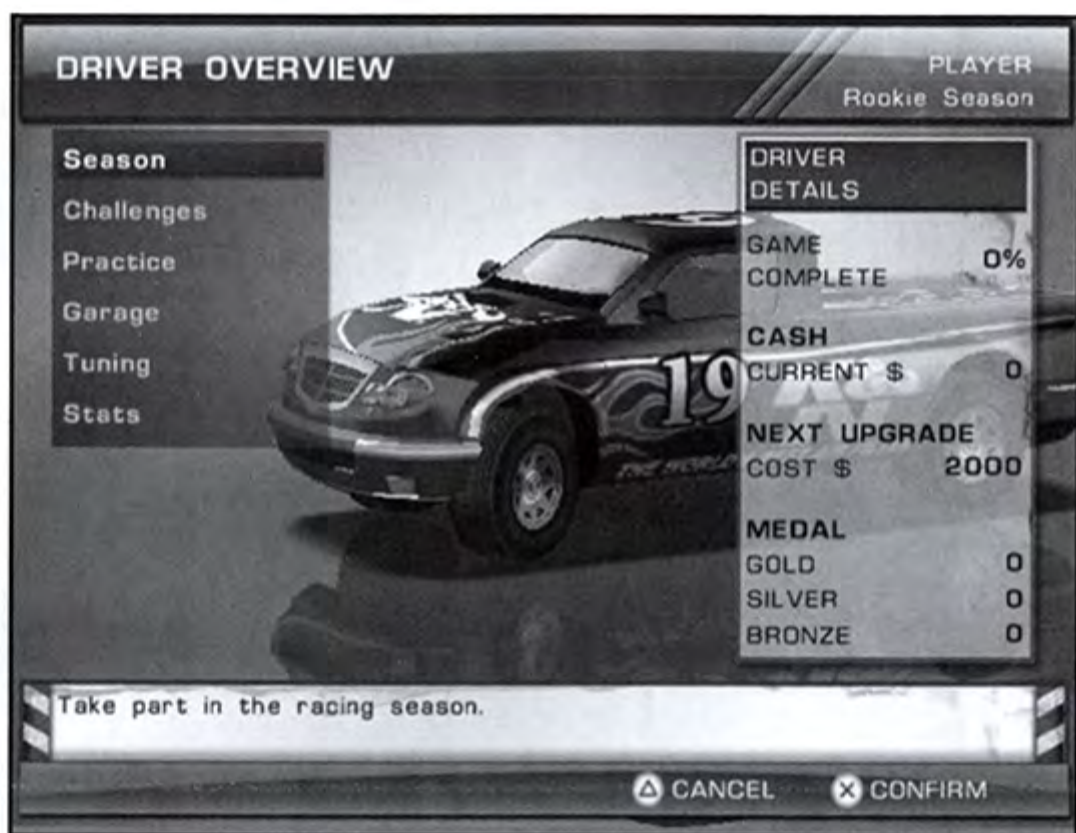
The Quick Race mode is designed to give the player the opportunity to enter a race immediately.

Using the left analog stick you can customize your race by choosing the car, team, track, number of laps and weather condition combination.

Just confirm your choice with the **X** Button.

The available Tracks and Cars depend on the Career mode progress (see Unlocking Vehicles).





## CAREER MODE

The Career Mode represents the heart of Super Pickups™. Once selected, the user must choose to represent one of six teams. Each team has their own special attributes that will enable the player to reap benefits as they progress through their career. Career Mode is divided into the following sections:

- Season
- Challenges
- Practice
- Garage
- Tuning
- Stats



## SEASON

There are four Championship categories for each Season. At the beginning of your Career you can only choose to participate in races in the first available championship. Each championship consists of 3 to 4 races. Placing 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any of the races will unlock the next Championship race. In order to complete the Season and go to the next one you will have to place 1st, 2nd or 3rd in all of the races. The Championship Seasons are as follows:

- Rookie
- Amateur
- Professional
- Veteran

## **CHALLENGES**

Challenges are ability tests. The racer earns money by competing in specific events.

## **PRACTICE**

In Practice mode you can choose to race against opponents or against the clock.

## **GARAGE**

Here in the garage, you can select the truck that fits the style of racing that the event dictates.

## **TUNING**

This section presents the upgrades you have gained along with its modifiers which enhances the characteristics of your vehicle.

You can find the detailed effect of the selected upgrade in the information box at the bottom of the screen.

## **STATS**

By entering this section, you will be able to browse through different categories of stats:

- Career Overview
- Driver History
- Opponents
- Teams
- Best Times

## **MULTIPLAYER**

In this mode you'll be able to challenge the most unpredictable opponent: a human player! Split-screen races with friends can be customized in the same way as a Quick Race. Therefore, the Track and Car combination depends on the Career Mode progress (see Unlocking Vehicles). There are 3 multiplayer game modes:

- Single Race
- Tournament
- Survivor



### **SINGLE RACE**

In Single Race mode, players can customize their race in the same way as in Quick Race. Each player can also choose a different pickup color.

### **TOURNAMENT**

Tournaments are a pre-defined series of races which players can choose from. There are 8 Tournaments available and each of them is different in terms of track length or track setting. Once the Tournament is chosen, players will be asked to choose the pickup and the pickup color. The player who wins the most races during a Tournament is the Tournament winner.

### **SURVIVOR**

Survivor races are special races in which players initially set the maximum level of Car Condition available (from 100% to 1%). Therefore, during these races players will have to pay special attention to the Car Condition gauge as wrecking the car will result in losing the race.
