# STARTING THE GAME



1. Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system.
2. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green).
3. Press the OPEN button to open the disc cover.
4. Place the *Tiger Woods PGA TOUR® 07* disc with the label side facing up in the disc holder, and then close the disc cover.
5. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate.
6. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

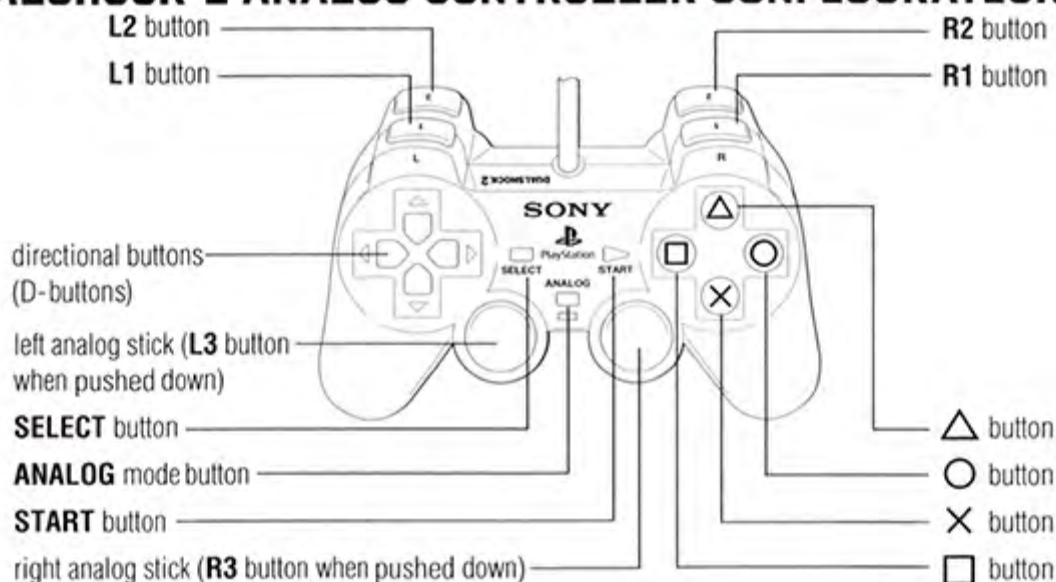
**NOTE:** When using the multitap (for PlayStation®2), a controller must be connected to controller port 1-A.

### DUALSHOCK®2 ANALOG CONTROLLER CONFIGURATIONS



## CONTROL SUMMARY

The dual analog swing system has been refined to make the quest for the perfect shot just a little tougher. Choose between an Alternate Swing style featuring the Shape Stick, or the Standard Swing style which allows you to swing and putt with the left analog stick. You also have the option to mix-and-match these swing types in any game mode. The default setting features Standard Putt with a Standard Swing style. For more information, see p. 4.

### ALTERNATE SWING

With the Alternate Swing, both analog sticks are used to take shots. The left analog stick controls the backswing and downswing, while the right analog stick determines where the club hits the ball—and the resulting trajectory of the ball in flight.

**To hit the ball straight:** Press the left analog stick straight down to begin your backswing—the closer you get to the peak of your backswing before pressing the left analog stick up for your downswing, the closer your swing will be to 100% power.

If the club's potential power is more than the distance of the shot, shorten your backswing to compensate. For example, if your pitching wedge can hit the ball 90 yards, but the pin is only 45 yards away, use half of your backswing.



**To hit the ball at an angle:** Press the left analog stick back diagonally then press the left analog stick up in an opposite straight line to hit the ball straight in that direction.

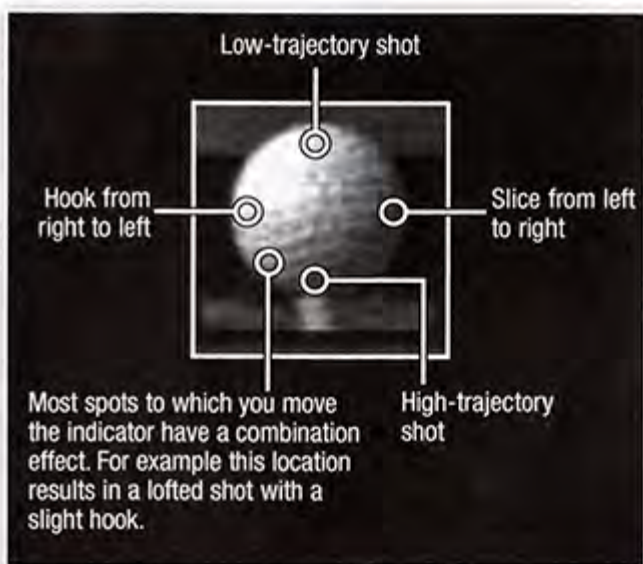




## SHAPE STICK

Where the club impacts the ball determines the shot's trajectory. You control the point of impact with the right analog stick.

The golf ball graphic on the bottom-right corner of your screen is your guide. Move the impact indicator anywhere on the ball to dictate its flight. Wherever the indicator is located at the moment of your downswing determines how the ball is affected.



## PUTTING

With Alternate putting, you need to read the greens and judge the distance to the cup before each putt.

### READING THE GREEN

Use the green grid and camera angles to determine the slope and speed of the green. The faster the beads move on the grid, the faster your ball will roll.

You may need to scope out your line from different perspectives. These are the camera angles available on the green:

- L1 button** Shows you the angle from behind the hole. Press the left analog stick  $\leftrightarrow$  to rotate the view.
- X button** Lets you see the ideal line to the hole.
- button** Raises the camera for an overhead view.

### SINKING THE PUTT

The power of your putts is determined by how far you pull back on your putter. For example, on level ground, if the hole is five feet away and your maximum putting power is 10 feet, you should only pull back half way on your putter. You can change the maximum distance of your putter by pressing the **R1** button/**R2** button.

## STANDARD SWING

Set up drives, chip shots, and more by taking advantage of the Standard Swing style.

### BALL IN STANCE (BALL POSITION)

Where you stand in relation to the ball while swinging allows you to fine tune every shot. Greater trajectory and less roll are achieved with a forward stance, while moving the ball in stance stick (press the right analog stick  $\uparrow$ ) results in a lower trajectory shot with more roll. Moving the ball in stance stick (press the right analog stick  $\downarrow$ ) results in a higher trajectory shot with less roll.

**To hit the ball straight:** As you do when using the Alternate Swing, pull straight back on the left or right analog stick to begin your backswing, then press up to downswing. However, in order to fade or draw, you must pull back diagonally and press up in an opposite straight line to draw or fade the shot.

## PUTTING

Use Caddy Tips and the ideal putting line when lining up a putt. The camera shows the perfect line of the putt while your Caddy provides you the key information needed to sink the ball in the hole. Pull back on the left analog stick or right analog stick for power, then push forward to trigger the putt.

Maximum putting power is determined by the location of the targeting marker. The key to good putting is to pull back and to follow through cleanly. Also, the right analog stick controls the impact indicator. Move the indicator  $\updownarrow$  to add distance or take a little off a putt.

## PLAY NOW

Play a round of golf without the pressure at illustrious Pebble Beach®. Work on every phase of your game with the help of game tips, before setting your sights on some of the game's biggest stars, including the best of them all, Tiger Woods.

### SETTING UP THE GAME/USER PROFILES

Be sure to create a User Profile to track personal accomplishments, save progress, or save your created Golfer (via EA SPORTS™ Game Face) before exiting a game mode.



### USING IRONS AND WEDGES

Pull out an iron when you need precision more than power. Be sure to shorten your backswing if the club's potential power is more than the distance of the shot.

### RECOVERING FROM HAZARDS

Even the legends find themselves in deep rough or a sand trap every now and then. Being able to recover from such lies is crucial to saving par. Make sure you check the current lie before shooting. If your ball is buried more than half way, you'll want to use much more club than you normally would.

### CHIPPING CONTROL

When you're just off the green, a chip shot may be your best option. Adjust the targeting marker based on the distance to the cup and the undulation of the green, and then chip away.

### WAGERING

Back your challenges with wagers before any round. Bigger odds are given to special accomplishments, so reap the largest rewards completing the toughest tasks.



## SHOT SELECTION

Choose your shot type based on each situation. The default club selection may not always be your best choice.

<b>Full</b>	Set up a full swing with the selected club.
<b>Punch</b>	Produce a low-trajectory shot to minimize the effects of wind, or to shoot from under tree cover.
<b>Pitch</b>	Places the ball on the green with minimal roll from up to 60 yards away.
<b>Flop</b>	With a higher trajectory and less roll, this wedge shot has a maximum distance of 51 yards. Use it to fly over obstacles or to stick the ball on the green.
<b>Chip</b>	A useful shot when you are too far away for the putter. The maximum distance for a chip shot is 40 yards.
<b>Putt</b>	When on the green, you putt the ball along the ground to the cup. The maximum putting distance is 180 feet.

## SAVING AND LOADING

Before exiting a game mode (or a menu where changes have been made), be sure to save your progress to a memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2). All unsaved information will be lost otherwise.

- To save or load a file, highlight the file you wish to load (or create a new file name when saving for the first time). Once the file is selected and/or named, the game data is either loaded or saved.

## NEW TEAM TOUR

Tiger Woods has assembled a team of champions and it's up to you to master your skills, recruit a team, and take them down.

### THE JOURNEY BEGINS

Your journey in Team Tour mode begins as a solo golfer. Yes, your long-term objective is to recruit a team of four players strong enough to challenge Team Tiger, but you must first prove yourself as an up-and-coming individual talent. By showing you have what it takes, others will want to join your quest to beat—and become—the best.

**NOTE:** You must first create a golfer before you begin an event in Team Tour mode. For more information, see *EA SPORTS™ Game Face* on p. 8.

### THE MAP

There are a number of challenges awaiting you all across the world. Whether it's an Elimination round on North American soil or a One-Ball event in Europe, the World Map presents plenty of opportunities for you to work on your game before setting your sights on Tiger Woods. When you first begin Team Tour mode most events are locked. You must first complete the available tasks to move on to the next challenge.

### AFTER AN EVENT

If you win an event, you can recruit defeated golfers to your squad, or fill an open slot on the team roster with a created golfer. Your team grows from one to two at first. Soon you'll be able to add more players to the team.

You can cash in purse winnings for a particular event, or money earned through in-game mini challenges in the Pro Shop. Here you can upgrade personal and team attributes to help you play—and look—better on the course. In time, you'll be ready to take on Tiger Woods and his team of champions.



## OTHER GAME MODES

- PGA TOUR® Season Mode** Use the calendar to navigate through up to 30 years of PGA TOUR® events. You can include up to three guest golfers and battle it out to see who comes out on top.
- Elimination Mode** Select a team with up to eight players and see if you have what it takes to survive an elimination-style round of golf. After every hole, the winning team removes an opponent from the opposing squad. The team that's left without an active player loses the match.
- Traditional Game Modes** Play by yourself or take on your friends in these 10 traditional game modes. Each game is described in detail when highlighted on screen.
- Skills 18** Up to four golfers can compete in this variation of stroke play where the goal is to hit the ball through the colored hoops, while keeping it in play.
- Real-Time Event Calendar** Participate in special events every day of the year such as player birthdays and holidays. Some events may also unlock various Pro Shop items.
- NOTE:** Real time events are based on the settings in your system's internal clock. See your gaming system's documentation for more information.
- Battle Golf** A two-player match play event where the winner of each hole removes a club from his opponent's bag or adds one back to his own.
- SkillZone** Test your skills in four mini-games, including Target, where the objective is to hit as many targets on the course as possible; T-I-G-E-R, where players challenge one another with difficult shots (which then must be duplicated by their opponent); Capture, where players claim and steal targets throughout a course; and Target2Target, where quick aim and accurate shots are key.
