- This disc is intended for use only with PlayStation 2 consoles with the NTSC U/C designation.
- Do not bend it, crush it or submerge it in liquids.
- Do not leave it in direct sunlight or near a radiator or other source of heat.
- Be sure to take an occasional rest break during extended play.
- Keep this compact disc clean. Always hold the disc by the edges and keep it in its protective case when not in use. Clean the disc with a lint-free, soft, dry cloth, wiping in straight lines from center to outer edge. Never use solvents or abrasive cleaners.

INTRODUCTION

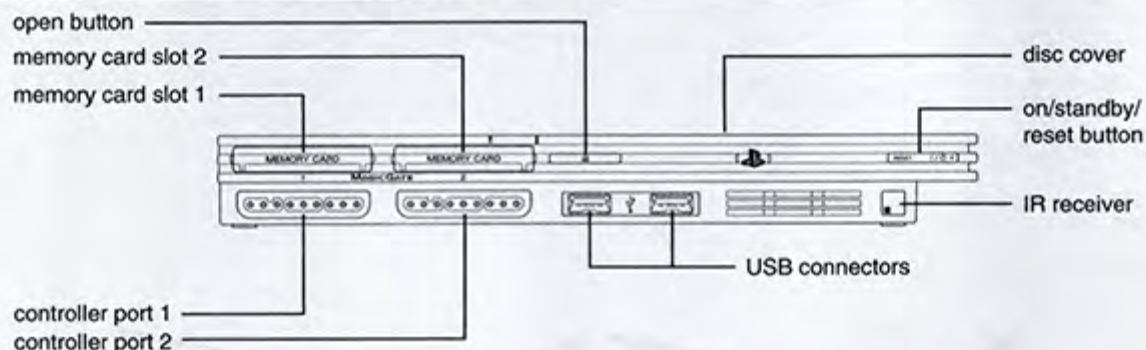
Ultimate Board Game Collection contains twenty different games that have been played in numerous countries around the world throughout history. Each game has its own set of rules and visuals, though all the games are accessed in a very simple and intuitive way.

The rules of each game can be viewed on the screen, allowing you to learn how to play games you've never played or maybe never even heard of before.

Each game allows you to choose different rules and options along with an environment and graphic customizations. While all twenty games can be played from the very beginning, you can unlock trophies by completing various goals within each game. You can see how many trophies you have by visiting the trophy room, or check out what you need to do to unlock a specific trophy.

PROFILE MANAGEMENT

To load a previously saved profile, simply start Ultimate Board Game Collection with a memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2) in MEMORY CARD slot 1 which contains your previously saved profile. Selecting Load from the initial menu option will load this previously saved data, unlocking your trophies and restoring settings such as your volume and music style choice.



Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions supplied with your system. Check that the system is turned on (the on/standby indicator is green). Insert the ULTIMATE BOARD GAME COLLECTION disc in the system with the label side facing up. Attach game controllers and other peripherals as appropriate. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

Memory Card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2)

To save game settings and progress, insert a memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2) into MEMORY CARD slot 1 or MEMORY CARD slot 2 of your PlayStation®2 system. You can load saved game data from the same memory card or any memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2) containing previously saved games.

MAIN MENU

After choosing to start a new game, or load a previously saved game, you will be presented with a screen showing five of the twenty games. Pressing left or right on the directional buttons will change the highlighted game. As you change the selection, you will see an additional game appear on the right or left side of the screen. When you have selected the game you wish to play, press X.

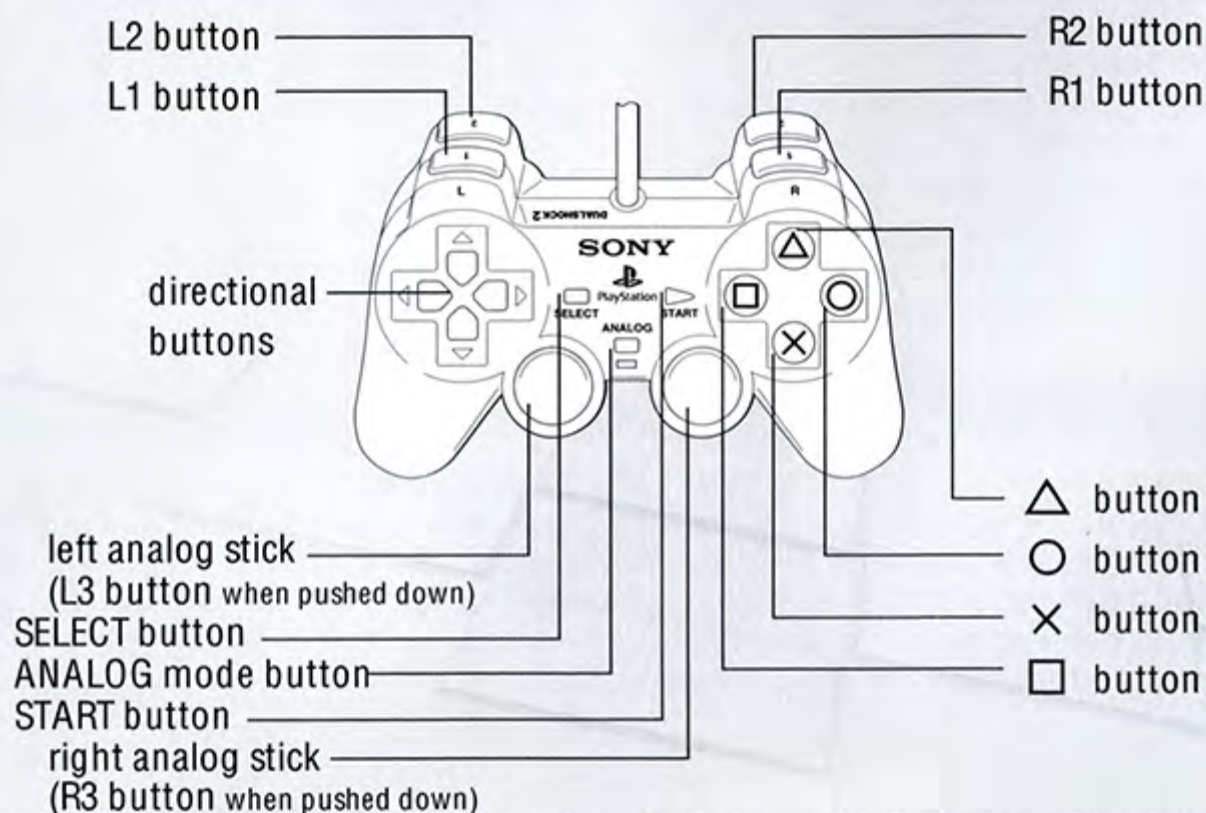
An option menu for the selected game will then appear (note: there is no option menu for Word Cubes). Once again using the directional buttons, you can use up and down to set focus on either the pieces used or the environment, while left and right on the directional buttons will allow you to change the highlighted option.

When you are happy with your option selections, press X to continue. If you press Δ, then your previous selection is cancelled and you are free to select a different game.

Pressing the SELECT button from the Main Menu will take you to the Trophy Room.

Note: Not all games have more than one environment available to them.

While each game uses slightly different controls, they all follow a consistent style making it easy to change between games.

Directional buttons... highlight a piece or move a selection

Directional buttons non-game... menu and item selection

Left analog stick... adjust view

× button... select a piece/confirm an action

× button non-game... confirm/select highlighted menu item

□ button... help screen

START button... in-game pause menu

GAME START OPTIONS

Every game has an additional set of options presented to you after it loads. These include setting the number of human players and the computer opponent's difficulty level. In addition, some games will have options for various rules or board configurations.

As with other menus, use up and down on the Directional buttons to choose which option you want to change and then left and right to adjust the highlighted option. Pressing × will begin the game with the displayed selections. Pressing △ will take you back to the previous screen, allowing you to adjust the player setup for the game.

To play a game with more than one player, use game start option menu to change the player type to Human for each real player you want to add. **When playing the game, just pass the controller to the player whose turn it is.**

Note that some games can only be played by one human player, such as Naval Battle and Dominoes.

Pressing SELECT from the main menu will take you to the Trophy Room. Before the Trophy Room is displayed, you will have an opportunity to save your game state. Select YES with the right directional button and press X to save your current game and then proceed to the Trophy Room. Selecting NO will take you directly to the Trophy Room. Once at the Trophy Room you can view the different Trophies you have unlocked, or see what task must be completed to unlock a specific trophy.

For each of the twenty games there is a trophy you can unlock. Each game has a specific goal you must complete in order to unlock the trophy. When you unlock a trophy and finish playing the current game you will be given the opportunity to save your current game.

PLAYING THE GAMES

Once you've set the options and players, the game gets underway. Pressing the □ button within every game will bring up a control guide, showing you which buttons are used and what they do. You can also use this menu to get rules help on each of the games. Pressing the right directional button will take you through the instruction screens. Pressing the left directional button will return you to the control guide screen. Pressing □ will exit the help screen and return you to the game.

Pressing the START button brings up the options menu. See the previous section for more details on the Options Menu.

OPTIONS MENU

This is accessed from within each game by pressing the START button. Use the up and down directional buttons to select an item.

To adjust the music or sound effects volume, select the volume item you wish to adjust with the up or down directional buttons, and then increase the volume by pressing the right directional button, or decrease the volume by pressing the left directional button. When you are happy with the new volume settings, select continue and press the X button.

To jump to a new game, highlight the Game item with the up or down directional buttons and then use the left and right directional buttons to select a new game. Press X to quit the current game and load the newly selected game.

You can select the style of background music that plays during a game. Using the up and down directional buttons, highlight the Soundtrack option and then press the left and right directional buttons to change the style. Note that if you move of a style and then back to it, a different track from that style will begin to play.

The other options are accessed by highlighting them using the up or down directional buttons and pressing X.

When you are done, select Continue and press X to return to your game.
