Circuit Mode lets you test yourself on some of the most bizarre courses ever—on snow, in mud, even underground—against a tough bunch of competitors who don't mind playing dirty if it means coming out on top! How do you prepare for this madness? Training Mode gives you all the practice you need to beat the seasoned pros you'll be facing! Best of all, up to eight friends can join in the fun! Dirt Trax FX uses the super-advanced FX chip to give you real-time rendering that puts the thrill of wild motorcycle racing right under you! You won't believe your eyes! Can you master the daunting circuits of Dirt Trax FX™ ? Can you take it through Radical, Nightmare and Doom circuits, all the way

to the Forbidden Circuit? It takes a special kind of player to take it to that twisted extreme!

REVIT UP! LOADING:

1. Make sure the power switch is OFF.

2. Insert the Dirt Trax FX™ Game Pak as described in your SUPER NINTENDO ENTERTAINMENT SYSTEM® instruction manual. If you wish to play a two player game, make sure both controllers are inserted at this time.



3. Turn the power switch ON. When the Dirt Trax FX™ title screen appears, you will see four choices:



Password, One Player Mode, Two Player Mode and MultiPlayer Mode.

MENU SCREEN

On this screen, and all menu screens to follow, press the X or A BUTTON to confirm a menu choice and the B or Y BUTTON to return to a previous screen and/or delete any choices you have made. With this in mind, getting through the options in the game should be a snap!

PASSWORD

After completing an entire circuit, you will receive a password, which allows you to pick up play at the next



circuit. To input a password, press LEFT or RIGHT on the CONTROL PAD to bring up the desired letter, then move to the next position by pressing UP or DOWN on the CONTROL PAD. When you've correctly entered a password, press the X or A BUTTON, and you will then return to the main menu.

ONE PLAYER MODE

In a One Player Mode game, it's you alone against the bitter competition of Dirt Trax FX!

TWODIANTRIVODE

In a Two Player game, you and an opponent battle for first place on any of the torturous tracks in any game mode, including Circuit, Training and Rad Tag modes.

If Multiplayer Mode is selected, you're in for a rough and tumble revving match! Players take turns using controls 1 and 2 until up to eight players have competed! After choosing this mode, a menu will appear with various player number options.

On this screen, you will be asked to select 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, or 8 players. With the UP or DOWN arrows on the CONTROL PAD, select the number of players who will be playing the game, and press the A BUTTON to confirm the choice.

After selecting the number of players, it's time to get to the

muscle of the matter: Bike Selection!



There are four different types of motorcycles you will be able to choose from. Select whatever bike size you wish to race with. The descriptions for various bikes are as follows:

*50CC EASY

This bike represents the easiest level of difficulty. The 50cc bike is the lowest, and the least powerful bike available in Dirt Trax FX. This bike is perfect for beginners. The 50cc bike is available for each and every race in the Circuit only. Practice playing Dirt Trax FX and try racing with this one. When you have defeated the first circuit with this bike, you will be returned to the main menu and be able to enter the Radical Circuit, and after it is defeated, then the Nightmare Circuit, on the 125cc bike.

125CC (NORMAL)

This bike represents the normal level of difficulty. The 125 bike is slightly more powerful than the 50cc, and is for those players who feel comfortable with quicker speeds and additional power. The 125cc bike is another great bike for practicing, and is available for each and every race in the Motocross, Radical and Nightmare Circuits. After all three of these circuits have been defeated with the 125cc bike, you will be returned to the main menu and be able to enter the Doom Circuit, and after it is defeated, then the Forbidden Circuit, on the 250cc bike.

250CC (HARD)

This bike represents the hard level of difficulty. The 250cc bike is much more powerful than the 50cc and the 125cc bikes, and is for those players who are familiar with the many tracks in the game, lots of power, great speeds and challenge. This bike is the most powerful bike available for the five circuits of the game. Or is it? Rumor has it that there is a special hidden 500cc bike available to the winner of the final race of the Forbidden Circuit...

500CC (MASTER)

This bike will not appear on the main menu until all five circuits of competitive game play have been defeated.

The rumored 500cc bike is thought to be the most powerful bike in the entire game, and much practice

will be needed to effectively drive this extremely powerful and speedy machine. We are told this 500cc bike is only accessible when the Forbidden Circuit is defeated. Can you defeat the Forbidden Circuit and discover if this bike exists? Only time and talent will tell. As soon as the 500cc bike is accessed, it can be used for each and every track in the Motocross, Radical, Nightmare, Doom, and Forbidden Circuits.

After the bike size has been selected, you will be able to select which character you wish to play as a Dirt Trax FX racer!

THE MARIOUS CHARACTERS IN THE CAME



The time has come to pick a racing personality. There are eight brutal and bad-to-the-bone racers you will be able to select from. Each of these racers has their own distinctive theme song that matches his or her personality. While in the character selection screen, move the cursor from character to character to hear the special theme song. To view the character attributes for the character surrounded by the cursor, press Select. (To exit the character selection menu screen, press Select a second time. You will be returned to the character selection menu screen.) To select the character surrounded by the cursor, press the X or A BUTTON.

HAWK:

He is a strong personality. His biking skills are impressive. You'll find Hawk is always rip roaring and ready to go.



BLADE:

Blade is a beautiful addition to the dirt bike racing world. She is absolutely ruthless when it comes to her drive to win. She has great biking skills.





SLASH:

He is a medium aged addition to the world of dirt bike racing. His biking skills are about average. He is not known to be a dirty player, but he loves to win.



HOG:

Hog is pretty much the biker to end all bikers. After cruising around the country for months on end on his bike, Hog has decided to enter the dirt bike racing championships!



SPIKE:

Spike is among the youngest racers in the entire world of dirt bike racing. He is small, but bad to the bone!



FANG:

Fang is the youngest member of the dirt bike championship racing circuit. He strikes quickly, and swerves in and out on opponents like there is no tomorrow. Watch out for this guy, if you do not select him yourself.





TALON:

Talon is the most brutal racer in all the racing circuits that make up the dirt bike championships. Watch out for her -- she's a demon!



NAILS:

Nails is a great biker, with a short temper and a great riding style! Watch out for him. He powers around turns, and always tries to run the straightaways. He's a pretty tough match!



T-REX: WHO IS HE?

The king racer of Dirt Trax FX is a brutal and mysterious opponent called T-Rex. Listen closely for him!

He'll make some noise. It's your job to shut him up!

CHARACTER SELECTION FOR MODES OF GAMEPLAY:

In the One Player Mode you will be able to select a character to race as in Dirt Trax FX. You will be able to select any character you wish and may, in-between circuits, return to the character selection screen and select a new racer.

In the Two Player Mode (either racing in Circuit play, Training or two player Tag) you and another player will be able to select any character and may, in-between circuits, return to the character selection menu screen and select new racers. Player one will select his or her character first, and Player two will select his or her character second.

In the Rad Tag and Multiplayer Modes, three to eight players will be able to play Dirt Trax FX. In each race, two human players will play against the other computer racers. The Rad Tag and the Multiplayer Modes of game play for Dirt Trax FX alternate, which means that all other human players will wait their turn to play against one another as only two human players can play the game at any given time. In the Rad Tag and Multiplayer Modes, you and up to seven other players will each be able to select characters to race as in Dirt Trax FX. You and the others players will be able to select any available

character. Player one will select his or her character first with controller one.

Player two then chooses with controller two and so on, with odd numbered players using controller 1 and even numbered players using controller 2, as shown below:

In all Multiplayer games, including Rad Tag, it's important for each player to remember what characters they selected to avoid confusion when the time comes to play Rad Tag or to race. There are times where rematches may occur, and players actively participating in the game as characters are eliminated. Good luck to you!

GHARACTER THEMESONGS

In the One Player Mode the game player's character will have his or her theme song played for the entire race! You're jammin' and slammin', but hopefully not into the walls surrounding the racing tracks!

In a Two Player Mode of game play, the game player who is in the lead, will have his or her respective theme song played. If there is a lead change, the song will change to whoever the new leader is. Listen carefully!

In the Rad Tag and Multiplayer Modes, the theme song of the player who is not "IT" will be played. Try as hard as you can to avoid becoming it to keep your tune rollin'!

GAME MODES

Dirt Trax FX has three basic game modes.

CIRCUIT

There are several successive circuits in Dirt Trax FX, each composed of multiple courses which must be mastered in order to advance to the next one. Complete all the courses in one circuit and another, more difficult circuit becomes available. Begin with the Motocross circuit, and see if you've got what it takes to go all the way to the insane challenges of the

Forbidden Circuit!

In Circuit mode, you compete against a field of tough opponents to master the various tracks of each circuit. Before each race, the required finish order for advancement is given. In order to advance, you must be within the specified field of finishers. To beat a circuit, you must come in first on a majority of the courses.

Each race is for a specific number of laps. The number appears on screen before the race. During a circuit race, your progress is tracked by on screen indicators which display the elapsed time, the lap number, lap time and your position in the race. At the end of race, a number of results screens appear. The first displays a complete run down of each player's times for each lap, as well as his or her best lap time. Then the best player will be shown. Next you will see a screen which shows each racer's rank, name, total time, and points earned. Actual players' results are highlighted. After that, it's on to the next course, on to the next victory, on to next crazed circuit!

TRAINING

In Training mode, you can practice on all the courses of a particular circuit before entering actual competition. Choose Single Race to practice against a full field of competitors on any course, or try Practice to get some solo laps under your wheels. This is a great way to become familiar with your bike and the various turns, jumps and hazards of each course!

RAD TAG

In Rad Tag mode, you play a leaping game of hide and seek with a solo competitor. A timer counts down while you're "IT", and when it runs down, you're out! Tag your opponent by running

into him or her. Your theme music will play as long as you're NOT "IT". When you're tagged, your opponent's theme music will play. Try to keep your theme music in the top ten! Be careful of running into the walls, as doing so



will automatically make you "IT"! Having a hard time locating your quarry? Try getting on top of the walls for a better view!



A number of courses are available in the Rad Tag mode. These differ depending on the number of players involved. In Two Player and Multiplayer games, you play on regular Motocross courses or on the

special Rad Tag courses. After choosing your Rad Tag course, you must choose your opponent. Different opponents have differing abilities, making them easier

or almost impossible to beat, depending on your choice!



HOW TO CONTROL YOUR MOTOR OF

The following is a quick reference guide for the operation of the controls in the Dirt Trax FX.



THE START BUTTON:

The Start Button confirms a menu choice. When Start is pressed during a race or a game of Rad Tag, the game is paused. To resume game play, after the game has been paused, press Start again.

THE SELECT BUTTON:

The Select Button will enable the game player to view the character attributes of any racer while the character selection screen is on the screen. Select a character face and press Select to view the characters attributes; press any button in order to return to the character selection screen.

THE CONTROL PAD

Press the Control Pad Down to move the motorcycle's front tire upwards and wheelie over jumps and obstacles, or to leap over walls, while moving, to drive back onto the track if you accidentally jump out of it.

Press the Control Pad Up to level out your bike, and return your bike's front tire down onto the ground after a wheelie has been "popped."

Press the Control Pad Right, to move right, and press the Control Pad Left, to move left.

While turning to the left, always press the Left TRIGGER simultaneously with Left on the Control Pad.

While turning to the right, always press the Right TRIGGER simultaneously with Right on the Control Pad. This is a key control feature for effective rounding of turns and bends, especially those that are very sharp!



THE X BUTTON:

This button is your accelerator. Pressing this button will allow your bike to be launched full throttle into the race! On Menu screens, both the X and the A BUTTONS confirm menu choices.

THE B BUTTON:

This button is your brake. Press this button to stop your bike completely. Pressing this button on any of the various menu screens moves you back to the previous screen.

THE A BUTTON:

This button is also an accelerator.

THE Y BUTTON:

This button is your 2/3rds acceleration button. Pressing this button will allow your bike to be launched, at 2/3rds throttle, into the race.

LEFT AND RIGHT TRIGGERS:

Use these when turning.

Now you know all you need to know to make it in this muddy, mad motocross maelstrom! Get in there, get your bike started, and go get 'em! One word of caution: DON'T LOOK BACK!


