# Important Health Warning About Playing Video Games

#### **Photosensitive Seizures**

A very small percentage of people may experience a seizure when exposed to certain visual images, including flashing lights or patterns that may appear in video games. Even people who have no history of seizures or epilepsy may have an undiagnosed condition that can cause these "photosensitive epileptic seizures" while watching video games.

These seizures may have a variety of symptoms, including lightheadedness, altered vision, eye or face twitching, jerking or shaking of arms or legs, disorientation, confusion, or momentary loss of awareness. Immediately stop playing and consult a doctor if you experience any of these symptoms. Parents should watch for or ask their children about the above symptoms—children and teenagers are more likely than adults to experience these seizures. The risk of photosensitive epileptic seizures may be reduced by taking the following precautions:

- · Sit farther from the television screen.
- · Use a smaller television screen.
- · Play in a well-lit room.
- · Do not play when you are drowsy or fatigued.


#### **CHOOSE TEAMS/STARTING LINEUPS**

After selecting NHL® teams for the upcoming game you have the option to adjust your starting lineups and strategies. You can set your Quick Plays, along with strategies for specific lines, including your power play and penalty kill units,

#### **QUICK SETTINGS**

Select the skill level for the next game, along with camera angles, rules, and period length. From the Advanced Settings screen, set your Line Changes to AUTO, OFF, or MANUAL, or Shot Aim to AUTO or MANUAL, When set to MANUAL, you are in full control of the action.

#### EA SPORTS" SKILL STICK

For the first time ever the right stick is your hockey stick. Quickly move **a** for a quick wrist shot pull **a** to wind up for a slapshot, or move **a** for a deke defenders and goalies.

**NOTE:** If you are moving down on your screen rather than up, the above controls work in the opposite direction.

Take on the role of GM (general manager), coach, and player and run your favorite NHL franchise for up to 10 seasons. See if you can live up to your owner's expectations by increasing profits, capturing division and conference titles, and most importantly, winning the Stanley Cup®.

#### **MESSAGE CENTRAL**

#### **TEAM MANAGEMENT**

#### **CREATION ZONE**

Create a new player or edit someone you already created by customizing every detail about him. The Player Info screen lets you choose your first and last name, position, number, handedness, birthday, hornetown, height, weight, and year drafted. Then go to the Appearance screen to determine how your hockey star is going to look. After that, you can adjust all of his skills at the Attributes screen, distributing points to everything from speed and adjlity to endurance and toughness.

#### **ROSTERS MANAGEMENT**

Cut players, edit lines, determine jersey numbers, and set default rosters of every team in this menu. Make sure to go to save rosters before exiting to lock-in your changes.

#### **SETTINGS**

Rules, gameplay settings, volume settings, visual settings, controller settings, video calibration, and the EA SPORTS™ TRAX are all accessible here.

# **DYNASTY MODE**

- ➤ In Dynasty Mode, you now have the ability to place players in the Minor Leagues. These players don't count towards your team's salary cap, leaving you money to spend elsewhere.
- Placing your young players in the minor leagues helps develop them early on but as they get older they need to move up to the NHL roster to keep improving at an optimum rate.

#### ON THE ICE

- ➤ With unprecedented vision control, strafe the blueline on a power play or create space from the defender while still seeing the entire ice. Press and hold and you will always face up ice. Couple this with the EA SPORTS Skill Stick and you'll enjoy having 100% control of your player.
- > If your opponent is expecting a one-timer, surprise him with a wrap-around.
- ➤ Taking a timeout during the 3rd period can be crucial to refreshing your lines' fatigue and boost, setting them up for the game-tying or game-winning goal.
