If your TV is PAL 60 compatible it is highly recommended that you enable the PAL 60 option in the Xbox 360 setup menu. This will provide smoother game play and enhance your enjoyment of Rumble Roses XX.

To set your console to PAL 60

- 1. In the Xbox 360 Dashboard, select the System blade
- 2. Select Console Settings and press (1)
- 3. Select Display and press (A)
- 4. Select PAL Settings and press (1)
- 5. Select PAL-60 and press (1)
- 6. When prompted if you want to keep these new settings, confirm by pressing (1)

If you do not know whether your TV is PAL 60 compatible please refer to the user manual that came with the TV or contact the manufacturer.

QUICK MATCH

In Quick Match you can choose the match format and opponent.

SINGLES MATCH

Entries: 1 to 2 players A pure and simple one-on-one match-up.

PHM (Pure Humiliation Match)

Entries: 1 to 2 players

A one-on-one match that can only be ended by an H-move.

TAG MATCH

Entries: 1 to 4 players

A two-on-two match that ends with a pin fall or submission by any of the wrestlers.

HANDICAP MATCH

Entries: 1 to 3 players

A one-on-two match. For the two-person team a submission or pin fall by either partner ends the match.

3-WAY ROYAL

Entries: 1 to 3 players

A three-way battle royal, in which the first one to defeat any opponent with a pin fall or submission becomes the winner.

4-WAY ROYAL

Entries: 1 to 4 players

A four-way battle royal, in which the first one to defeat any opponent with a pin fall or submission becomes the winner.

STREET FIGHT

Entries: 1 to 2 players

A one-on-one match on the Street stage. The first one to win two out of three rounds by depleting the opponent's health becomes the winner.

QUEEN'S MATCH

Entries: 1 to 2 players

A match that takes place on the Island Resort stage, in which the winner can force the loser to go through a penalty game.

Display ability parameters

Fight a one-on-one match on the Street stage. During a Street Fight health gauges will be displayed for each wrestler. When a wrestler's health gauge is depleted she loses the round.

Winning two rounds will win the match. In addition, some of the controls are different than in standard matches.

: CHANGES ON THE STREET STAGE ::::

- 1 You can perform a grappling attack in one step from a standing position.
- 2 You can perform a rising attack while getting up from a fall.
- 3 You can press the **Button** while stepping to perform a step attack, which will knock your opponent into the air.
- 4 You can only dash forward.
- **5** You can step by pressing the Directional Pad and the 🙆 **Button**.

12: QUEEN'S MATCH



Fight a one-on-one match on the Island Resort stage, with an added bonus at the end! If you win a Queen's Match you can force the loser to go through a Penalty Game, and then just sit back and watch as the loser embarrasses herself.



When a character's popularity reaches a certain point she becomes a 'Superstar'. Her entrance sequence will be upgraded to a superstar entrance, and her moves will be upgraded as well.
	III	You can earn money by winning matches and then use that money to purchase items in the Shop. You cannot win money by playing against other people - you can only earn money when playing by yourself.
	III	After fulfilling certain conditions during your matches you can earn the right to participate in a Title Match. If you win a Title Match your character earns the title of 'Champion'!

You can perform a combination of strike attacks by pressing the **S Button** repeatedly. The number of hits in the combo will vary by character. If you press the strike attack button in conjunction with the **Directional Pad** you will perform a kick combo.

Each attack deals out damage to the Head, Body, Arms or Legs. When one of these parts takes damage an icon appears for that body part.

: GRAPPLING


There are two steps involved in grabbing and throwing an opponent.

Step 1 From the Standing Position

Press the **OBUTTON** and the **Directional Pad** to grab your opponent. Depending on the Directional Pad input you will enter either a standing grapple or a ground grapple.

Step 2 While Grappling

From a grappling position press the **9 Button** and **Directional Pad** again to throw your opponent.

: FINISHING MOVES

As you deal out damage to your opponent during a match the finishing move gauge at the top of the screen will build up. When it fills completely the counter will increase by one. This counter indicates the number of times you can use a finishing move.

All playable characters have Lethal Moves and Killer Moves. Lethal Moves can be used only when your opponent is in a specific situation; Killer Moves can be used whenever the gauge is fully charged.

Also, characters that start with a weapon can also perform a finishing move using the weapon. Other characters that pick up that weapon during the match will not be able to do the same move.

Lethal Moves



Once you have placed your opponent in a position that fulfils the conditions for the Lethal Move press the **Left Bumper**.

Killer Moves



Regardless of your opponent's position you can press the **Left Bumper** to perform a Killer Move.

Lethal Moves with Weapons

When a character that started with a weapon is standing in front of her opponent press the Left Bumper to perform a weapon-based Lethal Move.

H-Moves



As you land attacks and avoid your opponent's attacks your opponent's humiliation rating will rise. When her rating reaches the maximum point she will become humiliated for a set period of time. While your opponent is humiliated pull the **Left Trigger** to perform an H-move.

Reversing Killer Moves

Lethal Moves cannot be reversed, but Killer Moves can be reversed by pressing the **Left Bumper** and **Right Bumper** together when the cut-scene appears.

Reversing H-Moves

H-moves can be reversed by pressing the **Left Trigger** and **Right Bumper** together when the cut-scene appears.

Reversing H-Move Reversals

For H-moves only, if your opponent reverses your H-move it's possible to reverse it again. First, the cut-scene for the H-move appears, then the cut-scene for the reversal appears. At that moment press the **Left Trigger** and **Right Bumper** together to reverse the reversal.

During tag matches or handicap matches, if your partner character is waiting in the corner and both your finishing move gauge and your partner's finishing move gauge are full, you can unleash a XX Move - a wildly powerful double-team action movel XX Moves cannot be reversed.

The controls differ slightly depending on whether your partner is controlled by another player or the computer.

Performing a XX Move with a Computer-Controlled Partner Press the Left Bumper and Right Bumper together.

Performing a XX Move with a Human-Controlled Partner

First, the active character presses the **Left Bumper** and **Right Bumper** together. The XX preparation cut-scene will appear, and the partner must also press the **Left Bumper** and **Right Bumper** together. If successful the two characters will perform the XX Move. If the move fails the finishing move gauge will decrease by one.

Ability Parameters

As you fight your way through many matches your character's abilities will slowly evolve. Depending on how you fight your attacks may grow more powerful, and your walking may become quicker, etc. Your can view your ability parameters after a match ends, or on the Matchmaking screen.
